Project Paridhi

Project Paridhi can be done on any day of the year, but on 20-March-2017 equinox and solstices the sun is directly overhead on the equator or tropics of cancer/capricorn hence making the calculation easier. This project also celebrates the days of solstice and equinox and helps participants understand seasons and motion of the Earth. A total of 55 students participated in this project.

A presentation was given by SPACE Educator to explain about Eratosthenes experiment and how the entire activity of finding the shortest shadow can help us to find the Polar circumference of Earth. After a short break students assembled in the ground to setup their experimental apparatus. They started the activity by marking shadows at regular intervals. With the help of the shadow readings, students successfully found the sun angle and calculated the circumference of the Earth.

Accuracy result:

- 10 students have calculated the circumference of the earth with 95% of accuracy
- 12 students have calculated the circumference with 98.5% of accuracy.
