WORLD CANCER DAY

World Cancer Day is an International day marked on 4th February to raise awareness of cancer and to encourage its prevention, detection and treatment. World Cancer Day is led by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC) to support the goals of the World Cancer Declaration, written in 2008. The primary goal of World Cancer Day is to significantly reduce illness and death caused by cancer and is an opportunity to rally the international community to end the injustice of preventable suffering from cancer. The day is observed by the United Nations.

World Cancer Day targets misinformation, raises awareness, and reduces stigma. Multiple initiatives are run on World Cancer Day to show support for those affected by cancer. One of these movements are

#NoHairSelfie, a global movement to have "hairticipants" shave their heads either physically or virtually to show a symbol of courage for those undergoing cancer treatment. Images of participants are then shared all over social media. Also, hundreds of other events takes place around the world.



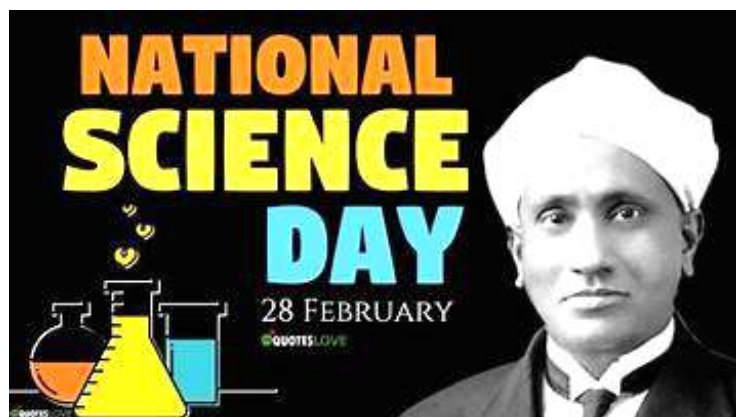
NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

National Science Day is celebrated in India on 28th February each year to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Indian physicist Sir C. V. Raman on 28 February 1928.

For his discovery, Sir C.V. Raman was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930.

In 1986, the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the Government of India to designate February 28 as National Science Day. On the occasion of the first NSD (National Science Day), (28 February 1987) NCSTC announced the institution of the National Science Popularization awards for recognizing outstanding efforts in the area of science and communication.

National Science Day is celebrated to spread a message about the importance of science used in the daily life of the people. To display all the activities, efforts and achievements in the field of science for human welfare. It is celebrated to discuss all the issues and implement new technologies for the development in the field of science. To give an opportunity to the scientific minded citizens in India. To encourage the people as well as popularize science and technology.

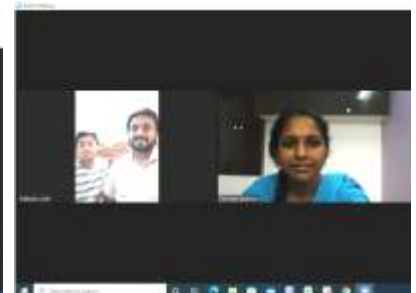
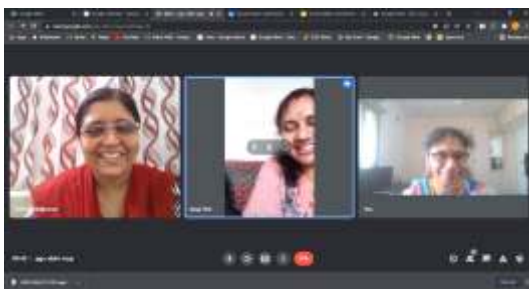
PONGAL CELEBRATION

- They really enjoyed their activity and performed so well.

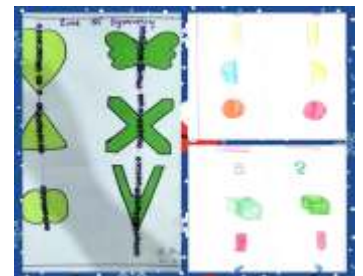
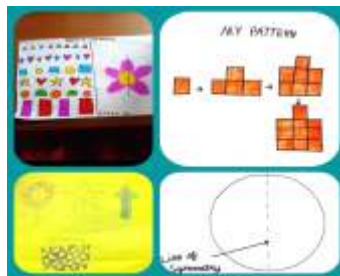

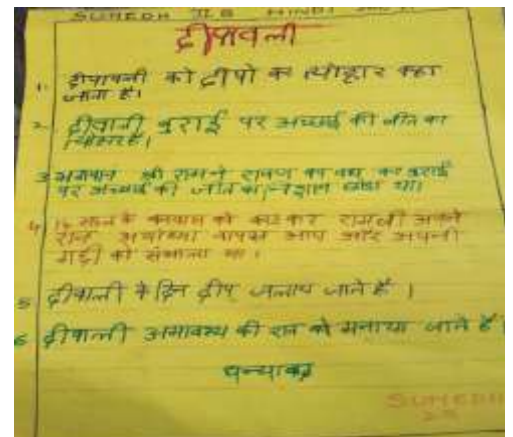
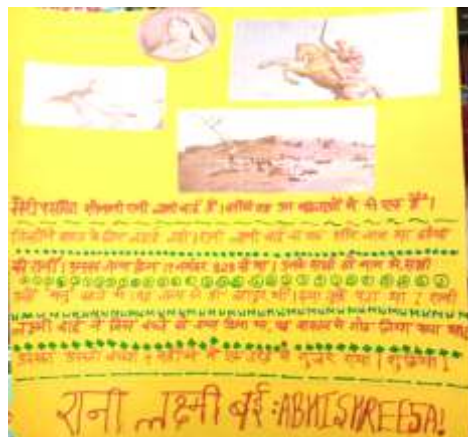


HINDI

FACTS ON REPUBLIC DAY

India won her freedom on the 15th August 1947 and became Republic on the 26th January 1950. The new Constitution of free India came into force with effect from this day.

It is a day of National rejoicing and the whole country celebrated this country with zeal and spirit.

The facts about Republic day are:

- The Constituent Assembly was headed by Dr. Rajendra Prasad. Dr. B.R. Ambedkhar was made the Chairman of the Drafting Committee. Dr. Ambedkhar is also known as “Architect of the Constitution of India” as he played a great role in making it possible for India to have a constitution that represents each community and person of the country. Dr. Ambedkhar became the first Minister of Law and Justice of Independent India.
- India had its first Republic day parade at Rajpath in 1955.
- Between 1950 and 1954, the Republic Day parade was held at Irwin Stadium (now National Stadium), Kingsway, Red Fort, and Ramlila grounds.
- Every year, the leader of a particular nation is invited to be the chief guest for the Republic Day parade.
