
SPECIAL DAYS

Gandhi Jayanti is an event celebrated in India to mark the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. It is celebrated annually on the October 2nd, and it is one of the three national holidays of India.

This day we also remember the death anniversary of the Late. Sri. Kamarajar, The freedom fighter, Former Chief minister of Tamil Nadu, and the President of Indian National Congress. He was popularly known as Black Gandhi among the masses and king maker during the Congress regime.





INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL CHILD:

The United Nations General Assembly adopted Resolution 66/170 to declare October 11th as the International Day of the Girl Child, to recognize girls' rights and the unique challenges girls face around the world.

The world is home to more than 1.1 billion girls under the age of 18, who are poised to become the largest generation of female leaders, entrepreneurs and change-makers the world has ever seen.

TO ENSURE THAT CHILD MARRIAGE IS ERADICATED FROM WITHIN THE SOCIETY, THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA ENACTED PREVENTION OF CHILD MARRIAGE ACT 2006 BY REPLACING THE EARLIER LEGISLATION OF CHILD MARRIAGE RESTRAINT ACT 1929.

THE RIGHT OF CHILDREN TO FREE AND COMPULSORY EDUCATION ACT, 2009.

THE RTE ACT PROVIDES FOR THE RIGHT OF CHILDREN TO FREE AND COMPULSORY
EDUCATION TILL COMPLETION OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION IN A NEIGHBORHOOD
SCHOOL. ... 'FREE' MEANS THAT NO CHILD SHALL BE LIABLE TO PAY ANY KIND OF
FEE OR CHARGES OR EXPENSES WHICH MAY PREVENT HIM OR HER FROM
PURSUING AND COMPLETING ELEMENTARY EDUCATION.



Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was an Indian aerospace scientist and politician who served as the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam, who also won the prestigious Bharat Ratna, is widely remembered as the 'People's President'. For his exemplary work in the field of science, the former President is also called the 'Missile Man of India'. The country observes his 89th Birth Anniversary on 15th October as World Students Day.

Navratri is called Golu or Bommai Kolu down South. It is the festive display of dolls and figurines arranged in steps. Each step is usually dedicated to a legend or folklore that is taught to the younger generation. This is the time of the year that the families revisit precious lessons learnt from timeless, age-old stories in the Ramayana, Puranas, and the Dashavataram. The steps represent the journey of life.

In North India, Navratri is celebrated as the victory of Lord Rama over the evil King Ravana. It culminates in the celebrations of the Ramlila which is enacted ceremoniously during Dussehra. The effigies of Ravana, Kumbhakarna, are burnt to celebrate the victory of good (Rama) over evil forces on the 'Vijaya Dashami' day.

These nine days are filled with special pujas, yagnas, homas, fasting, meditation, silence, singing and dancing honoring Mother Divine, her entire creation - all forms of life, all forms of art, music and knowledge. She is worshipped as the savior of mankind from ignorance and all forms of evil.

Without Dandiya and sweets, Navrathri is incomplete. Our Hindi students of Grade 4 and 5 welcomed the Navrathri season by wearing ethnic outfits along with sweets and dandiya decorations.






Why is Navratri celebrated in Jndia?

The word Navratri is derived from Sanskrit, meaning nine nights – nava (nine) ratri (night). ... In the East and various parts of North east India, Navratri is celebrated as Durga Puja, where the festival symbolizes the victory of Goddess Durga over demon Mahishasura, signifying the victory of good over evil.






What is the story behind navratri?

It is the main reason **behind** the celebration in Eastern and Northeastern states of India. It is believed that goddess Durga battled with the buffalo demon Mahishasura to restore peace and Dharma. She was successful and her success is commemorated every year through the Durga Pooja.














FRENCH ACTIVITY: MAGAZINE ARTICLE WRITING

Covid-19 ce sont des virus issus des coronaviriades identifiés pour la première go fois en 2019 en chine à Wuhan.p D'ou son appellation Covid-19. C'est-à-dire: CO= corona, VI=virus, D=maladie (en anglais), -19, parce qu'identifié pour la première fois en 2019. La covid -19 est une pandémie parce qu'elle touche tous les continents ou une épidemie qui infecte la planète. Car, jusqu' à ce jour, il n 'y a aucun traitement ni vaccin efficace contre covid-19.




