







SAFER INTERNET DAY



Sarojini was also a part of politics when she joined the Indian Congress party and got appointed as the Governor of United Provinces.














WORLD DAY OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

Students of Grade 5 explored the galaxy and space science with the help of role-play.

















1) Traffic Signal and Signs: Children from Grade 2 created digital drawing using MS Paint application.










2) Creative Tux: Children from Grade 1 designed their Greeting cards and solar system using Tux Paint application.










ART AND CRAFT
