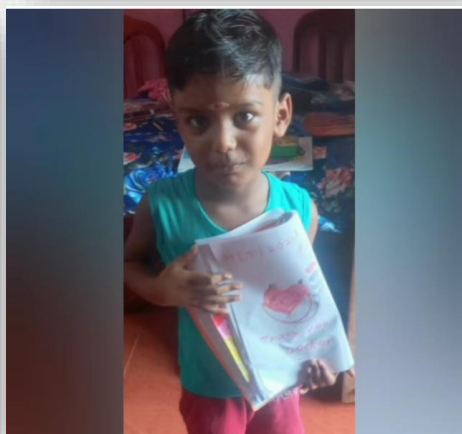
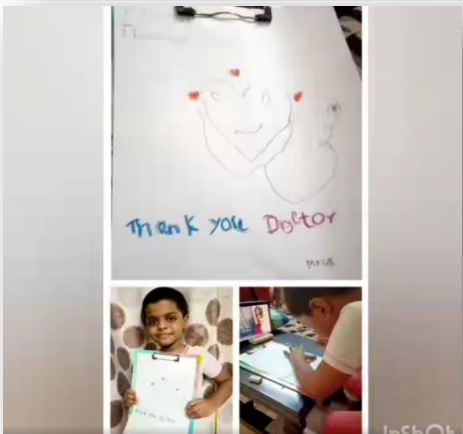
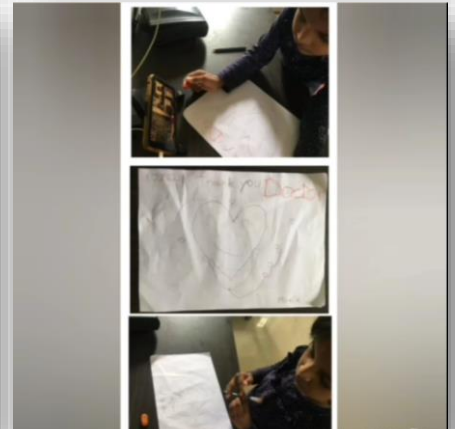
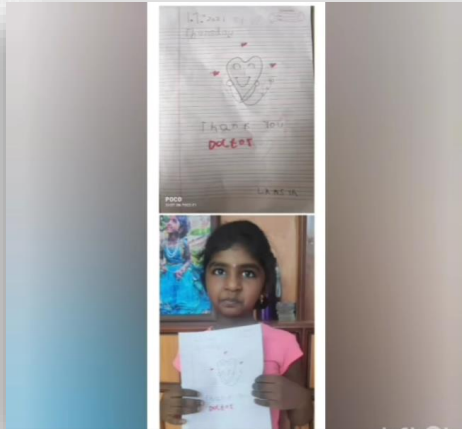
A special day - "NATIONAL DOCTORS' DAY "(1st July 2021) is celebrated to thank and salute the global heroes for their immense contributions to mankind.

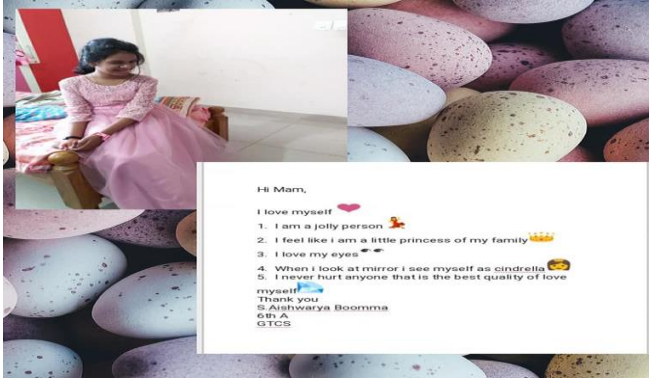
COMPLIMENT YOUR MIRROR

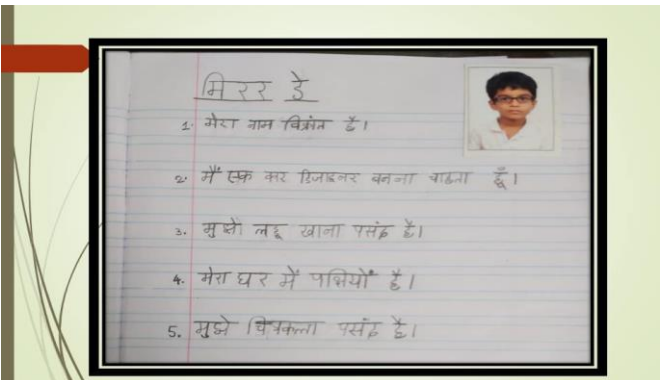
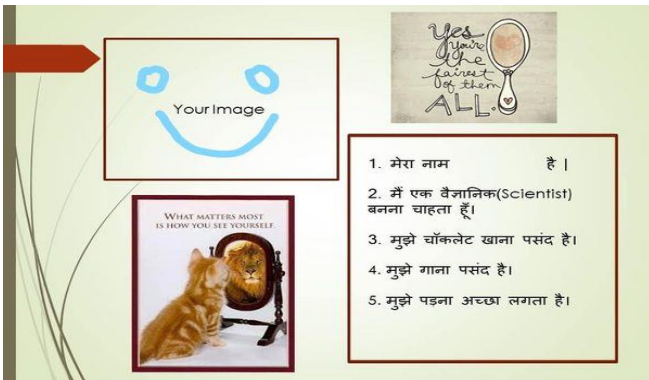
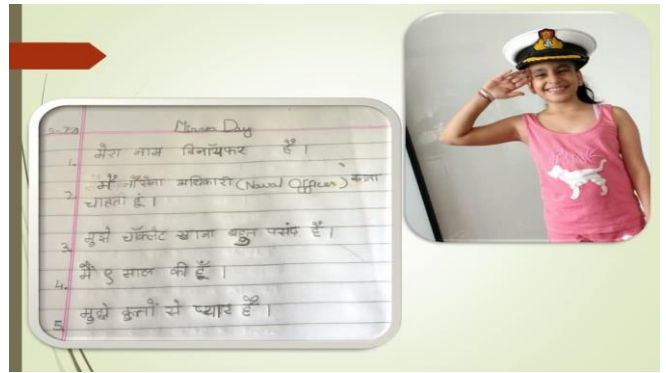
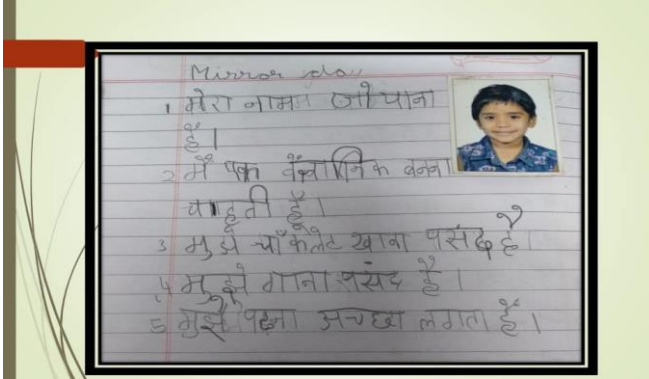
Children of Grade 6 participated in the activity- 'Compliment your mirror day'. All the students thoroughly enjoyed themselves and loved the activity.

NATIONAL SIMPLICITY DAY

What is simplicity? A state or quality of being simple or something easy to understand in contrast to something complicated. Henry David Thoreau, once said, "As you simplify your life, the laws of the universe will be simpler".

Thoreau was an author, philosopher, naturalist, abolitionist, historian, and transcendentalist. But at his heart, he was an eternal advocate for living a life of simplicity. That's why National Simplicity Day is celebrated annually on his birthday, July 12.

Thoreau encouraged people to live in a simple way by decluttering unnecessary things. He is best known for his book *Walden* and his essay *Civil Disobedience*, which inspired notable figures such as Leo Tolstoy, Mahatma Gandhi, and Martin Luther King Jr.

Who is Henry David Thoreau?

Henry David Thoreau lived in the mid-nineteenth century, in America. Social reformer — Naturalist — Philosopher — Transcendentalist — Scientist. These are just some of the terms by which the work of Henry David Thoreau can be categorized. Thoreau's writings influenced Gandhi's work in India, Tolstoy's philosophy in Russia, and King's civil rights stand in the United States. Henry David Thoreau lived for two years, two months, and two days by Walden Pond in Concord, Massachusetts. His time in Walden Woods became a model of deliberate and ethical living. His words and deeds continue to inspire millions around the world who seek solutions to critical environmental and societal challenges.

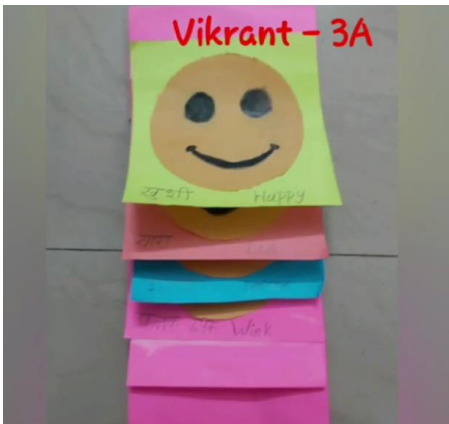
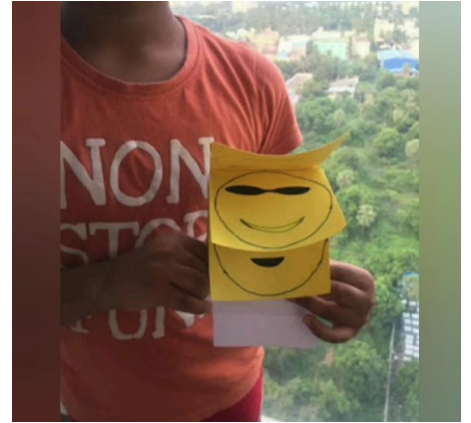

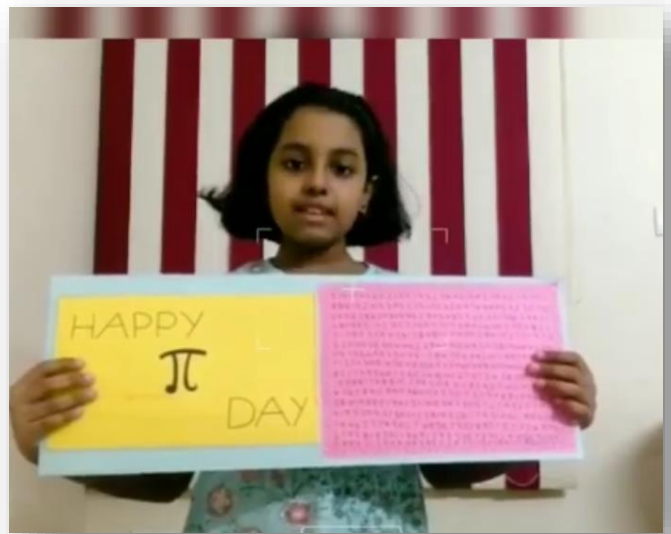
To celebrate the uniqueness of emoji world Hindi students of grade 1 to 4 created artistic illustrations of their favourite emojis and also made waterfall emoji card.

World Nature Conservation Day 2021: The day recognizes that a healthy environment is a foundation for a stable and productive society. This day also ensures the well-being of present and future generations.

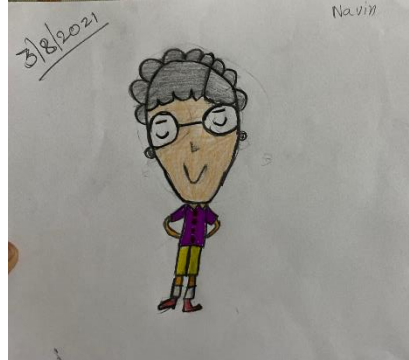
