
International Literacy Day

LEGO WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS

On 17th, 18th and 19th September 2018, training workshop on "WEdo 2.0, Mind storm EV3 and 3D printed" was conducted by Mr. Ramakrishna from Edutech for teachers of Gateway International School at IB campus. Teachers from other campus such as GIS, Shollinganullar and GIS CBSE, Padur joined the workshop with the GIS IB teachers. The workshop was scheduled between 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Day one, was dedicated to explore and learn the features of WE do 2.0 kit. The session was to unbox the kit and arrange all the elements in the respective place on the tray and learn the functionality of each element and familiarize with them. The teachers learnt the software features and explore software programming commands. The next session was to install the WE do 2.0 software on the laptop and connect the "HUB" with the laptop and learnt basic errors that may occur during the process and the relevant troubleshooting methods to address them. The last session was to teach a concept. The attendee's had to construct the respective model using the guide and teach the Science and math concepts to others. The session gave a great insight in to the exciting world of Robotics.















Field Trip to Mahabalipuram

On the way back students visited the India Seashell Museum. It is the largest seashell museum in India and is located at Mahabalipuram. It houses over 40,000 specimens of rare and unique seashells, fossils, shark teeth and whale fins which offers visitors an amazing visual treat and a unique perspective on Conchology. This trip to Mahabalipuram was memorable as the students visited one of the famous tourist places in India during World Tourism week.
