They trained us on CPR (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation), how to handle situations when a person or a child chokes also when a person had a fall. They also had our staff handle mock situations so that we are able to handle real life situations with much ease. The doctors then performed health screening for the staff. They monitored the height, weight the BMI index, also they tested the Sugar level and BP for all the faculties. The event proved very beneficial to all the staff as we were trained to handle any emergencies at ease.





## **Festivals and Celebration – Kindergarten Activity – 9<sup>th</sup> Dec 2019**

The students of K3 exhibited their learning on festivals and celebrations. They came up with an idea to create an e-invitation to invite our beloved principal, teachers, and our respected parents.
