

GUEST LECTURER ON COMMUNICATION MODELS

How the government systems influence the lives of the people – Field Trip by PYP 5

The students of PYP 5 had been for an educational trip to government offices to understand how the people work and the benefits and challenges they encounter working in a government organization. The students had many queries and were determined to get the answers from the government official jotting down word to word. At first, they were excited to visit the Post office at Kelambakkam and understood its mode of operation after interviewing the Post Master, he other employees and promised them to convince their parents to have a recurring deposit for themselves which is beneficial at a later stage. Then they visited the Electricity Board and gathered information from the Assistant Engineer; the hierarchy of the organization the roles and responsibilities and the job distributed evenly to the people who work to ensure that the people in and around the locality do not face any challenges with the Electricity Board. They were all geared up and with great excitement while visiting the Corporation Bank to understand the different roles of the people in the bank mainly the Branch Manager; the important aspect is the various schemes provided by the bank to ensure that people live a comfortable life planning to save for their future. Next, the students were curious in knowing about the local government, and were taken to the Municipal Corporation who served people in laying the roads, distributing water at all times, clearing the garbage, and help fix the repairs of the street lights. Last by not the least the students visited the Kelambakkam Bus depot to understand the importance of the Pallavan Transport and the efficiency of the people who work there. It was indeed an unforgettable experience as the students gained confidence, acquired knowledge and connected their central idea on 'How the government systems influence the lives of the people.'













Creating General Awareness – Ambulance

To create awareness about emergency situations and how to react during such situations, an ambulance was brought to our school campus on 31-01-2019. The EMT (Emergency Medical Technician) explained to the students about the parts of the ambulance and the first aid procedure that is being followed. PREVENTION OF SUICIDE: RAISING RESCUE

The objectives of the seminar are

- To impart training in psychological first-aid
- To connect to professional sources of help

- 3. Mr.S. Karthikeyan, Chief clinical Psychologist on "Rendering Immediate help (Psychological First Aid)"
- 4. Dr.V.Jaikumar, Assistant professor in Psychiatry Institute of Mental health on "Raising social support (role of significant others)"
- 5. Representative from SNEHA suicide prevention centre addressed on "Seeking professional help"










She exhibits Knowledgeable and reflective IB learner profiles by curiously involving in all the homeroom activities and she is also reflective in her learning.
