

This edition of Newsletter brings to you the events and happenings for the month of March 2021.


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PYP Collaboration meeting – 1st Mar 2021

The PYP collaboration meeting was held on the 1st March 2021 and the following were discussed.




LO: To learn the purpose of addition and to learn through play.

Let's Play to Learn!!!




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LO: To understand the art of making colorful optical illusion.





$\underline{PTM-MYP5-6^{th}Mar\ 2021}$



K1 and K2: - 8th Mar 2021




PYP Collaboration meeting – 15th Mar 2021

K1 and K2 Activities:


Learning Goal: To identify and name the shelters of different animals.

Students were involved in an interactive session where they learnt the names of shelters of different animals .

Students were introduced to the concept of forming patterns with shapes through a fun filled session where they identified the correct pattern from the pictures shown. Further, they displayed their understanding by drawing patterns using two or three different shapes and so on.



K3 Activities:


LO: To understand and identify the nocturnal and diurnal animals.

Children were involved in the photo inquiry session to become more knowledgeable by identifying the various nocturnal animals and diurnal animals which helped them to understand their adaptations related to their place of living as well as the way in which they identified their prey.



LO: To understand the structure of a sentence.

Children were brainstormed with the scrambled sentences along with the pictures to interpret and identify the words that could be used to frame the sentence and they tried to frame the sentence with the help of the color code used in the picture. Children found it interesting as it enhanced their communication skills.



LO: To develop their Self-management skills

Children reflected on their learning about the nocturnal animals and they started performing the simple craft work to make the nocturnal animals like hedgehog and the owl. They created the eyes by remembering the adaptation characteristics of these animals and enjoyed making craft works.

The MYP collaboration Meeting was held on the 16th Mar 2021 and the following was discussed.


* Encourage the teachers to follow IB Method of teaching strategy.


* Teachers were requested to prepare their own worksheet.

GUEST LECTURE - POETRY

Name of the Lecturer-Ms.Fiona Date: 17:3:2021 PYP 1,2&3

Ms.Fiona a DP facilitator was all set to make poetry easily understandable for the Grade 3 students.

Firstly, she brainstormed to say that there were no rules to write a Poetry, and she was clear on the guidelines for prewriting a poem.

The students interacted very excitedly as she asked them to relate the word 'RED' to different words as to form 5 words or even frame sentences on that word. The students then came out with their choice of words which caught all our attention, like blood, anger, food, vegetables, and many more.

Ms. Fiona articulated well orally on the 'Blackout list' which means to strike out words in a Newspaper using a black sketch pen and with the remaining words they can form writing a poetry.

Then the students caught a glimpse on the 'Concrete Poems, which Fiona explained was that it can be represented as a shape and the poem can be written in that shape.






Name of the Lecturer-Ms. Fiona Date: 16:3:2021 PYP 4,5&MYP 1

The students of grade PYP 4,5&MYP 1 participated in the guest lecture hosted by Ms. Fiona which was held on 16.03.2021. She discussed on the different types of poems and also on understanding the meaning behind the beauty of words by poets. She further associated the different colors to real – life situations. The students had gained knowledge on how to write a poetry which also helped the PYP 5 students connect the lecture to their theme "How we express ourselves". The discussion had an interesting approach and was a very interactive session.

Poetry is a form of storytelling. Writing poems can be intimidating for kids however writing poetry is less daunting when students can analyse a model. Colour poems show just how simple and enjoyable poetry writing can be learners participated actively by creating poems using freestyle writing. Painting with words to create art using emotions by involving the five senses. As George Bernard Shaw said, 'The best poems draw in their audience and spark the imagination. Imagination is the beginning of creation. You imagine what you desire. You will only have what you imagine. And what at last. you create you will.' This session gave the students the opportunity to connect personal knowledge and sensory perception to written descriptions using similes and metaphors.



Internal Assessment – 15th March 2021

Internal assessment is an integral part of IBDP learning. In view of this, an Internal assessment workshop on Mathematics was conducted on 18th March 2021 for DP1 and DP2 students. Ms.Kalpana, IBDP Mathematics examiner and facilitator from TIPS school conducted the workshop. The workshop provided in depth knowledge and understanding to all the students.






PYP Collaboration meeting -22nd Mar 2021

K1 Activities


Learning Goal: To identify the sound that different animals make



<u>K3</u>:


LO: To identify the names of the friendly insects in our environment.
