


PYP Summative Assessment- Unit 1 – 31st Aug - 3rd Sep



Students were able to communicate effectively and confidently answered the questions posed related to their chosen task.




PYP 4

Theme: Where we are in place and time


Central Idea: Evidence of ancient civilizations and its impact on the modern day societiess


The students inquired on the Diaroma on the artifacts from the ancient civilization.






MYP Collaboration Meeting - 31st August








Job Alike Session – 4th Sep 2021



- The application developed by Tinyivy has a broad way to classify students in different groups according to their learning level and the work can be assigned to them in different number of sessions needed.
- It provides teachers with the lesson plan for each session chosen along with the materials like worksheets and flashcards.
- The application also has its own library where the words are written with the TIPS to decode the sound and when the child is aware about all the sounds the TIPS can be removed to check their reading. It also has a translator which allows the teacher to create its own content with dictionary.
- Later the facilitator encountered all the queries by the teachers.




MYP Meeting – 6th Sep 2021

for everyone, where parents appreciated student's efforts and were amazed by their performances.










DP Language and Literature - 7th Sep 2021


Awareness on Electrical hazards and Safety – 9th Sep 2021

It was indeed very useful for the primary students as they gained knowledge and comprehended the contents clearly.






MYP Meeting – 9th Sep 2021

Meeting with the Middle Years Programme Co-ordinator and the Subject teachers.


- Ms. Dhara presented the Global Contexts Personal and cultural expression and Identities and relationship in depth

<u>Theory of Knowledge Webinar – 11th</u> <u>Sep 2021</u>

The DP core subject Theory of Knowledge provides us an insight to reflect on the nature, scope and limitations of knowledge and the process of knowing it. TOK enables the learner to consider what we already know and how to examine the evidence for claims to distinguish facts from opinions. Though TOK is one of the cores, it is learnt only by integrating with other subjects. Keeping this in mind, a TOK workshop was organised in our school on 11 th September, 2021 between 1pm to 2.30pm to train all the subject teachers to integrate TOK while teaching their respective subjects. The session was headed by the resource person, Ms. Shezin Siganporia, Assistant DP Coordinator & DF TOK



Coordinator, Fountainhead School Gujarat. The workshop enabled all the teachers to have a clear understanding of the ways to integrate TOK with their subjects.


Action/Minutes

- Teachers were enlightened about how they can help the children create E- Digital portfolios by summarizing about themselves, the knowledge they gained throughout the unit, the skills they acquired and each and every milestone they crossed to know about the topics learned with their selfreflection.
- So, the teachers comprehended that 2 best work of the student's inquiry process -Kath Murdock Inquiry cycle to be compiled and added in the digital E-portfolio, the UOI, English, Math, Visual Arts & PSPE.
- Additional Language, stand alone math, were topic specific concepts to be emphasized had to be taken into consideration to file the portfolio.
- A discussion on the exemplar of PYP 5 e-portfolio was
 displayed which gave a clear idea to the teachers as to how
 they can create student's digital portfolio and very
 importantly is how the students write the reflection based on
 the inquiry stage.
- To comprehend on the Enhanced PYP documents and the importance to connect the learning and teaching having the reference documents viewed to develop the practices that should be maintained in the IB school was emphasized and an overview of PRC was discussed.
- The visual art teacher collaboratively viewed the topics for PYP 1- 5 for unit- 2 and extended ideas to incorporate the topics and discussed with the homeroom teachers. The integration into the transdisciplinary for unit 2 was discussed and constructive ideas were shared.









PYP- UNIT 2 -INTRODUCTION SESSION – 14th Sep 2021


The day for the parents to witness the Unit 2 introduction session on Sep 14, 2021 was an event where parents took their centre to witness their wards upcoming learning progress.








Special Event Hindi Divas – 13th – 17th Sep 2021

DP Collaboration Meeting - 16th September


Meeting with the Diploma Years Programme Co-ordinator and the Subject teachers.




collectively gave a unified performance attracting everyone's interest. Their cuteness and sincerity were well appreciated by all.

Jaye had very interesting quiz to share and Celine's MC was very organized and systematic.


All the teachers, the principal and the students were overwhelmed and appreciated the little tots for their thoughtful performance.

- The Design cycle and the design criteria were briefed to him and the design guide was shared with him as well




MYP Collaboration - 21st Sep 2021

- Discussion on the difficulties that a special child faces during the class.
- Discussion on Understanding the problem behaviours and the types of problem behaviours of children with special needs.
- Discussion on identifying the problem behaviour by knowing the signs and symptoms.
- Discussion on the factors of behaviour problems and learning the common and possible factors in depth.

- Discussion on managing the behavioural problems step by step with the understanding of certain methods to assess the child.
- Discussion on the Functional behaviour patterns, that is to understand when and at what time the child behaves abnormally.
- Discussion on the Behaviour management strategies such as Change the antecedent, Extinction, Physical restraint, restitution etc.
- Discussion on the classroom management strategies such as defining the rules, focusing on the routines of the child etc.
- Discussion on the importance of rewarding children with special needs and knowing the different types of rewards to inculcate in the classroom.
- Discussion on the curriculum adaptation: Accommodation (The content of the curriculum won't be changed or modified) but how the teacher can practise the differentiation methods and strategies to teach the same curriculum but with more assistance to the children who need it. Modification(The content of the curriculum will be modified or reduced according to the learning difficulty of the child)
- Discussion on the Universal design for learning principles where the teacher will get to understand the strategies to inculcate in the classroom.
- An activity was assigned for the teachers to reflect upon the topics of discussion.

<u>Introducing our New SEN Coordinator – Ms. Saradha Priyadarshini</u>

The SEN coordinator initiated her work by observing children's activities in their classroom and their interaction with the teachers and their peers. A counselling form/self-analysis for the students was prepared in order to get to know about each and every child.

Also, a feedback form was prepared and circulated to the MYP teachers in order to collect information about each and every child. Based on the observation and the Teachers feedback, a list of students who required attention and further help were identified.

As a next step, assessment was initiated for a child, report was prepared and based on it, the following programmes goals are being set .

7.	Computer skills (typing)

Apart from this a plan was made to interact with the teacher about curriculum adaptations to be done for the child for the subjects then and where required. Also, form was prepared for PYP teachers in order to get feedback about the students of PYP.

A workshop was conducted on for PYP and MYP teachers' on the topic "Managing behaviour problems among children" where orientation was given on different behaviour problems that are commonly observed among children and management strategies were discussed. Also, classroom strategies that help children with ADHD and slow learners were also discussed.


