



They displayed the various sensory materials that could support their learning, and they sold juices and sweets to raise funds to help students with autism with the sensorial materials.




## **Submission of DP2 CAS to IB**

The MYP students of Gateway International exhibited their learning through their MYP **9th April 2022** at our school premises.














**PYP 5 Exhibition-The Sparklers, 2022** 



#### **Transdisciplinary Theme: Sharing the planet**

#### Central Idea: Our actions can have an impact and change the world around us.

The students had waited for this particular day, 'The PYP 5 Exhibition,' the culmination of their PYP journey, and indeed it was an awesome performance by every individual who showcased their presentation with pride and dignity.

The students were overwhelmed when the parents visited them, and without any hesitation and with a considerable agency as they had great confidence which led them to succeed and reach the expected outcome.

They set up personal booths in which they adhered to the social skills and displayed their learnings as chart presentations, Model presentations, and a few videos that connected to their learning on their laptops giving a deep insight into their conceptual understanding as they articulated their thoughts to the parents.

They explained the Kath Murdoch's inquiry cycle as to how they were tuned into understanding the Transdisciplinary theme, collaboratively framing the central idea, discussing the lines of inquiry, key& related concepts, and integrating all the subjects into the unit and researching the sustainable Development Goals to comprehend on the different issues and trying out ways in how they could resolve those issues. The principal, coordinator, homeroom teacher, and the Mentors guided them throughout the exhibition process, and with the support of the parents, they were able to achieve their goal settings.

They were very determined and stood firm in their decisions in attaining their Actions and serviceoriented Action. The students developed all the IB learner profiles and pointed out the ones that were more prominently evident in their learning. They also placed themselves on the Transdisciplinary skills and the areas where they achieved those set of skills along with the subskills.

Overall, the parents were very thrilled and the onlookers were amazed at how the little minds could accumulate so much information and were very determined that they wanted to share every bit of it.




# PYP Collaboration Meeting – 18<sup>th</sup> April 2022

# MYP Collaboration meeting – 30<sup>th</sup> Apr 2022


MYP collaboration meeting was conducted on 29th April 2022 at 2pm. The following discussions were made in the meeting,
