Teachers Orientation Program – 1st July 2021

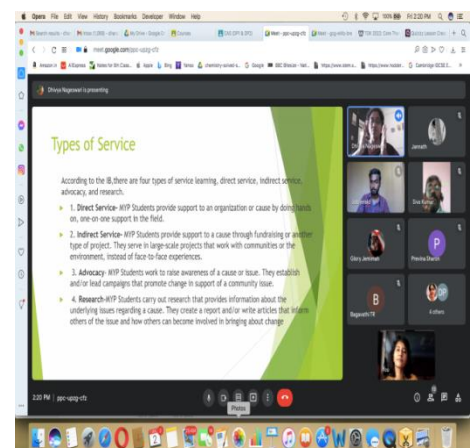
Teachers have three loves: love of learning, love of learners, and the love of bringing the first two loves together

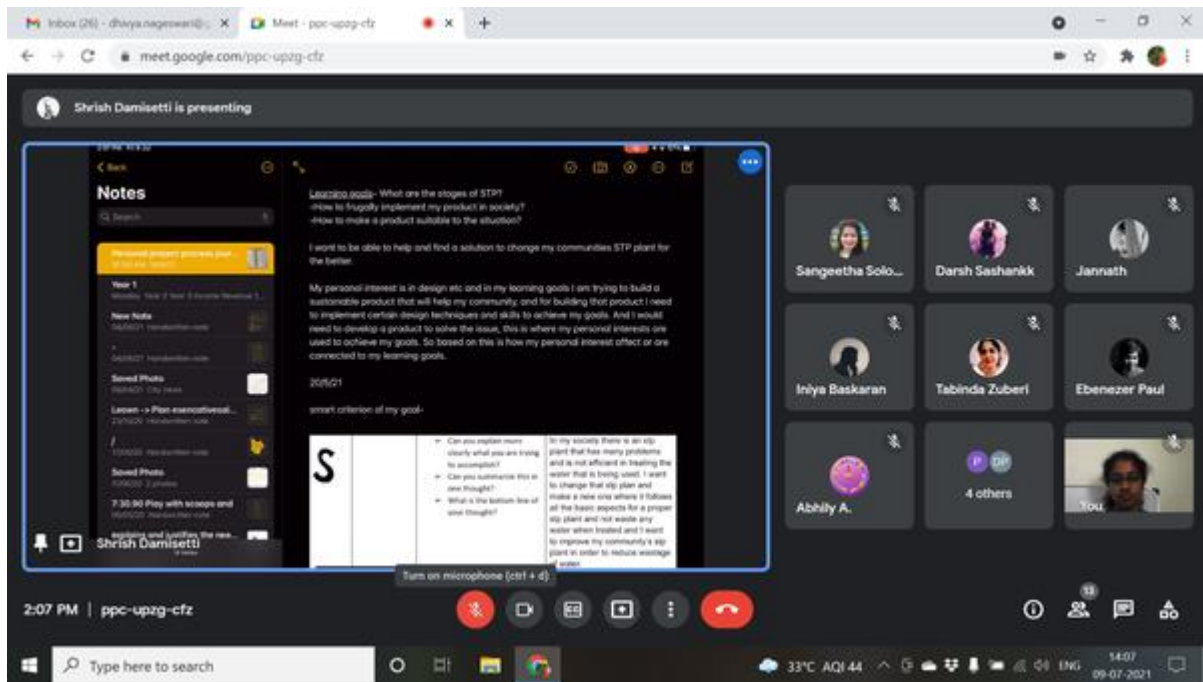
Service as Action Orientation – 8th July 2021

TOK Orientation – 13th July 2021

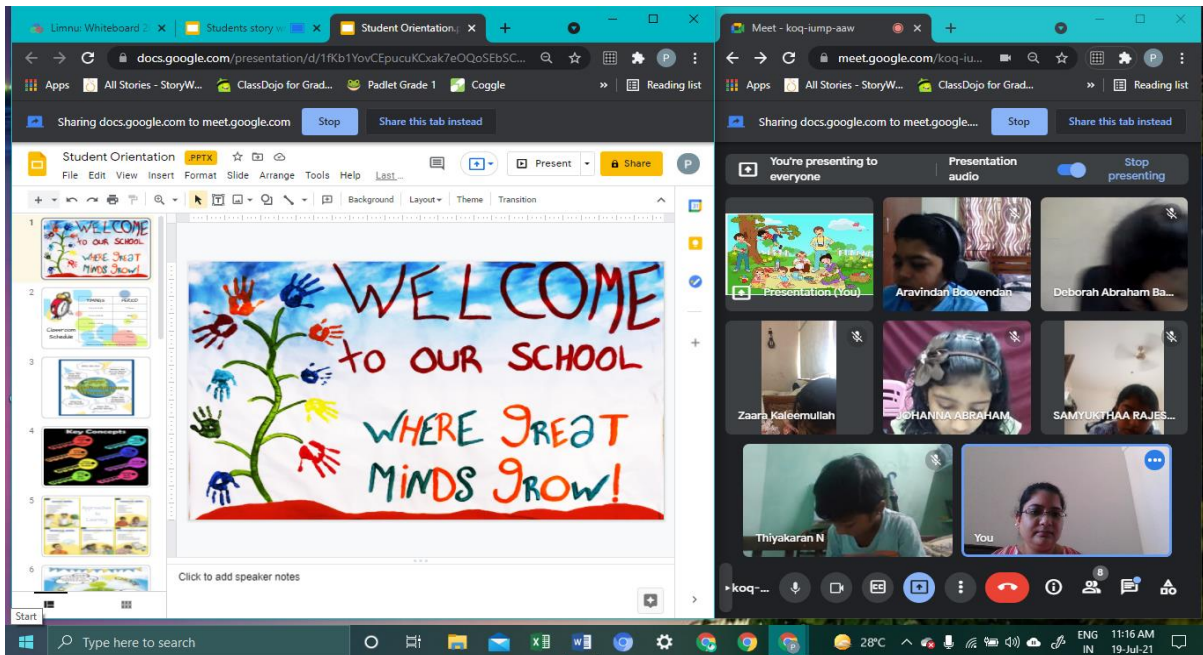

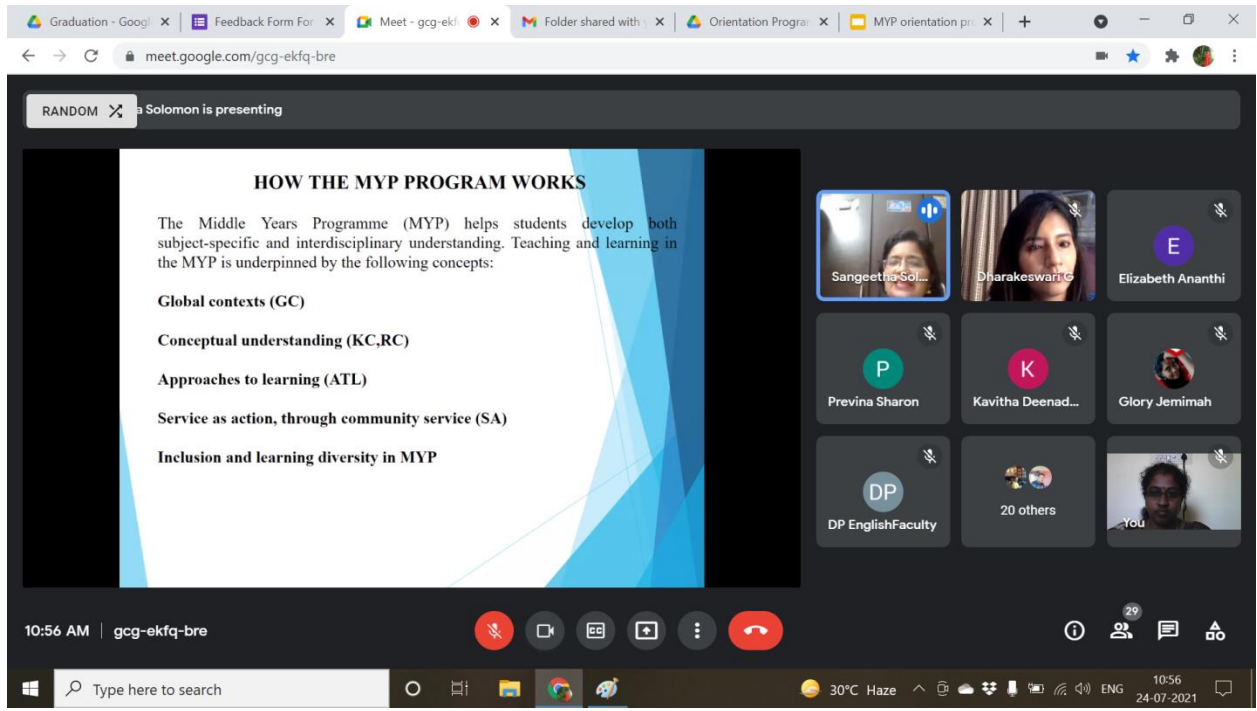
MYP and DP Parents Orientation – 24th July 2021

Plant a Sapling this Weekend Activity - 30th July 2021

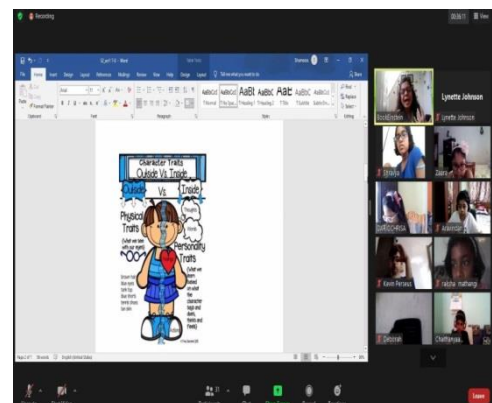

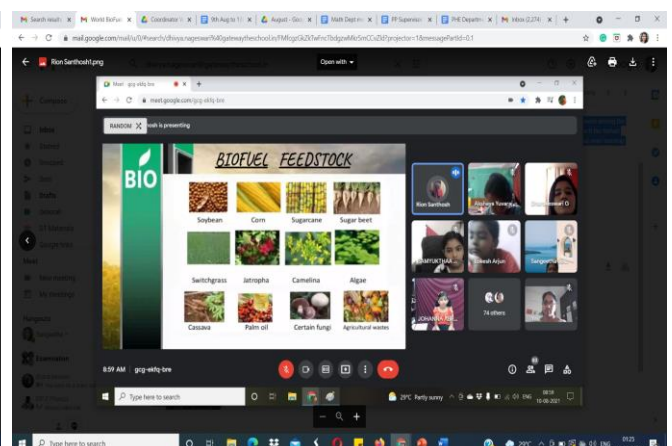
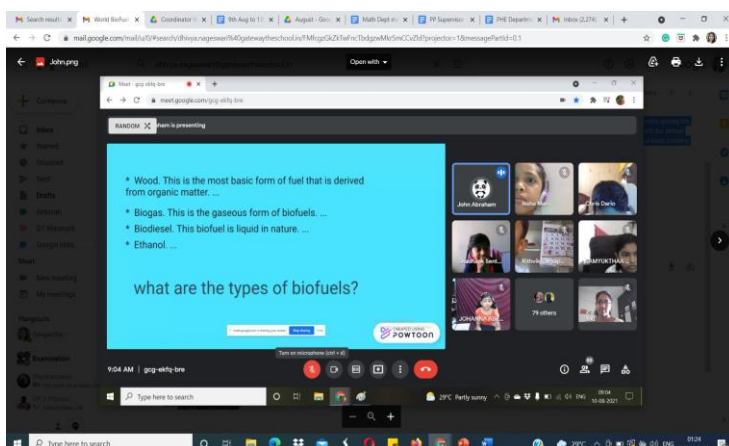
World BioFuel Day Celebrations:

To enhance the communication skills students were given an opportunity to participate in the creative writing workshop conducted by – Book Einstein

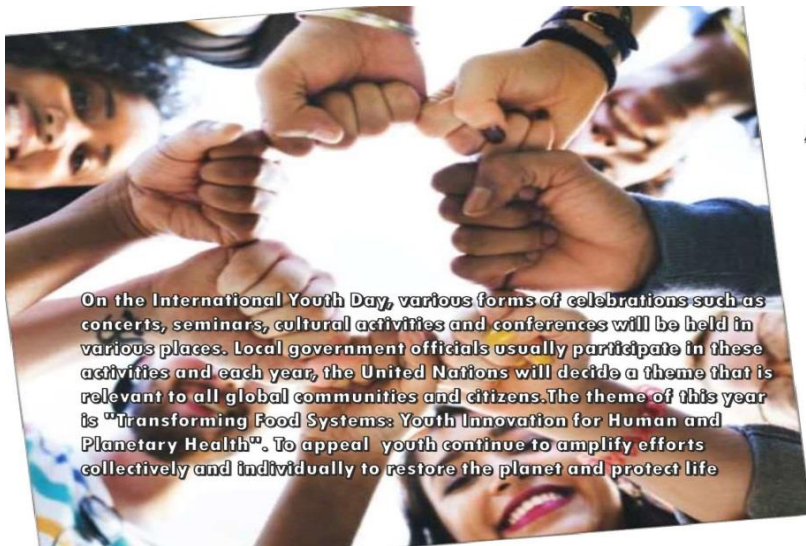

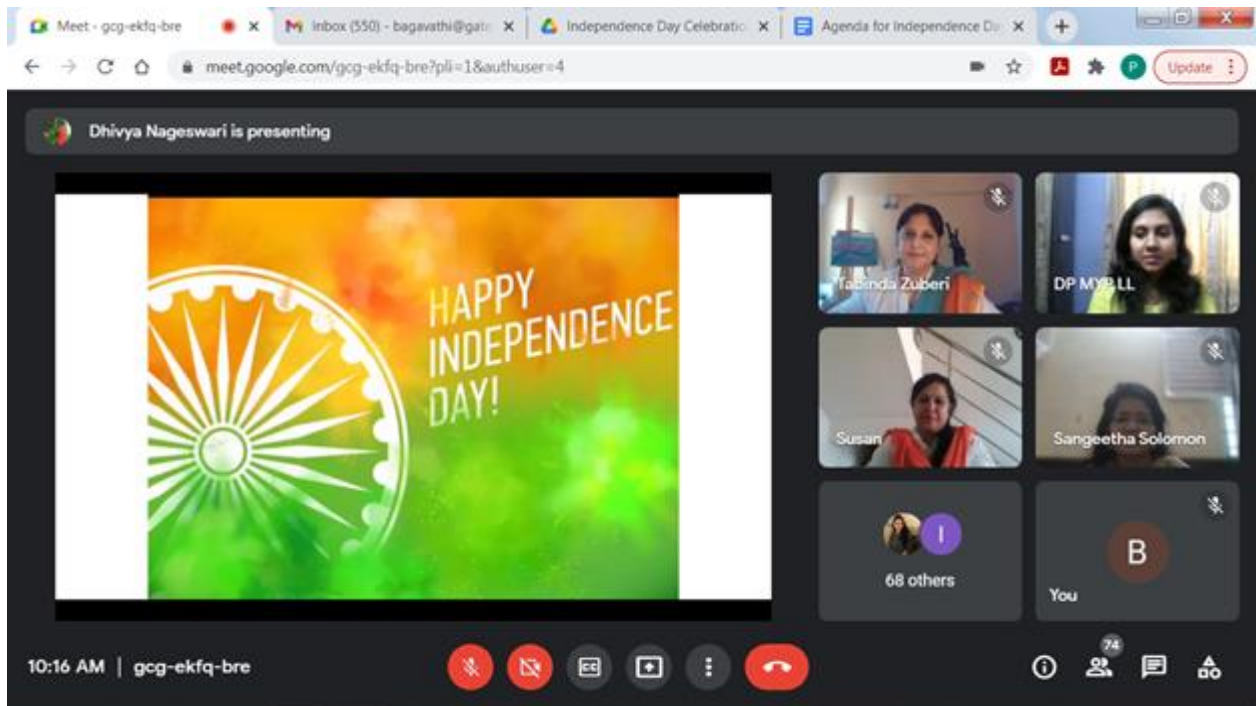
INDEPENDENCE DAY Competition – 14th Aug 2021

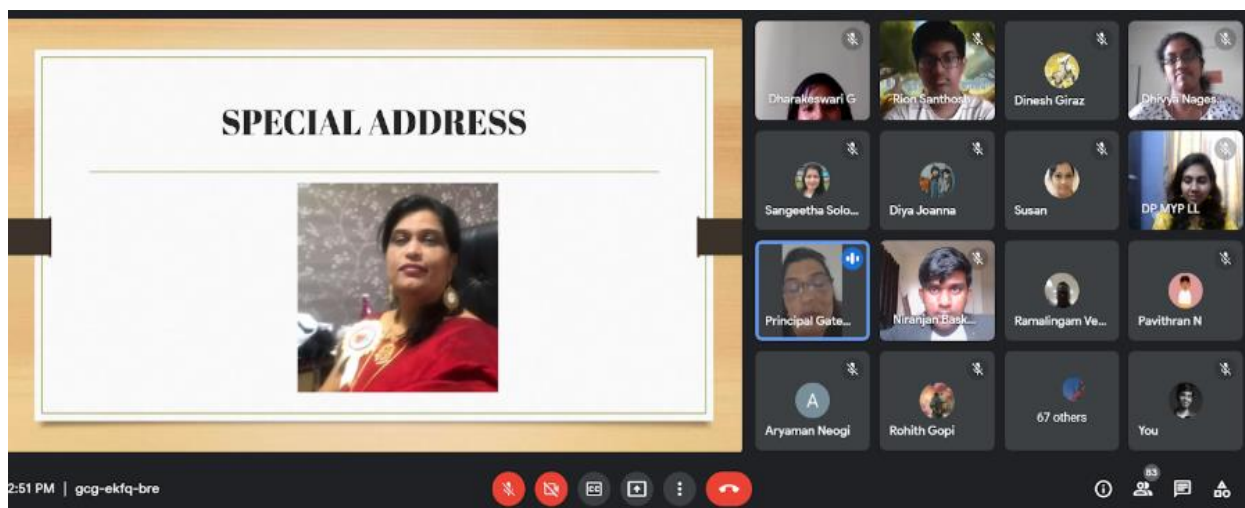

Investiture Ceremony – 27th Aug 2021

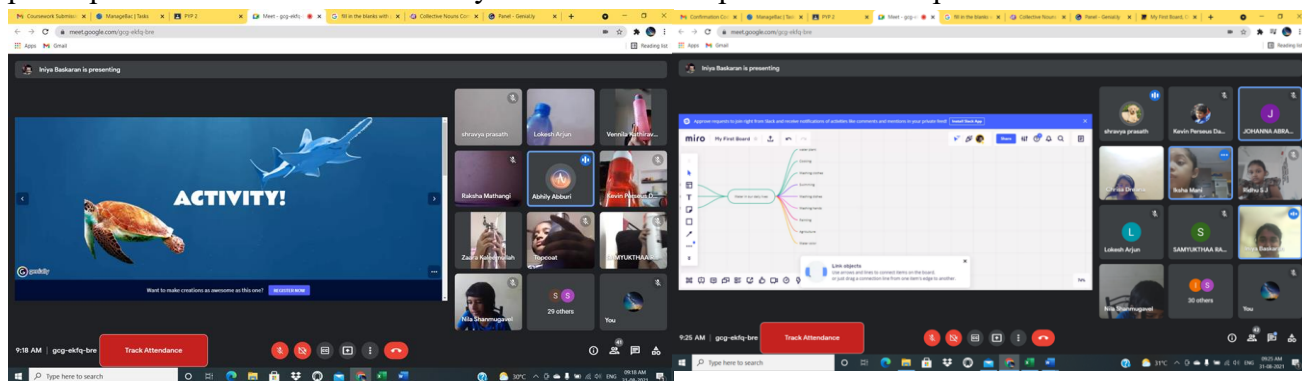

World Water Week – 31st Aug – 6th Sep 2021

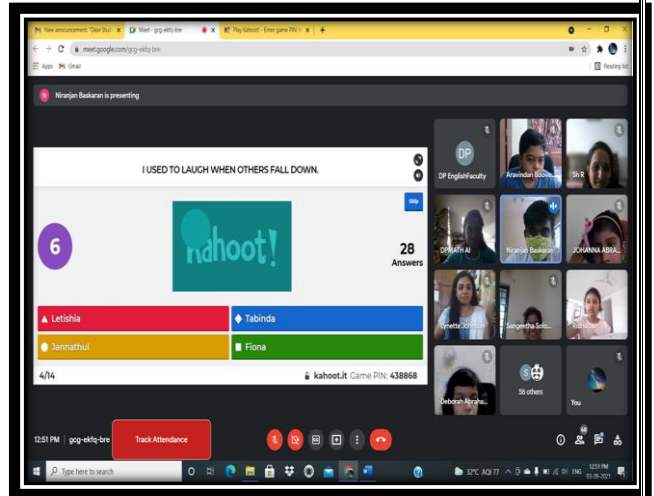
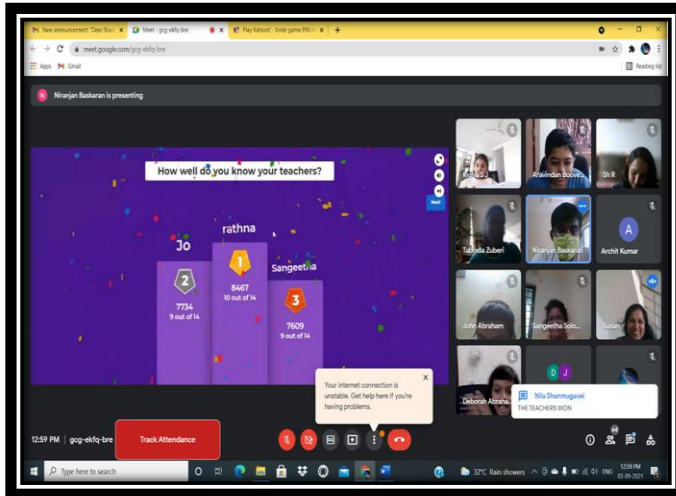

This day was full of fun activities and all the children and Teachers celebrated the TEACHERS DAY in a memorable way.



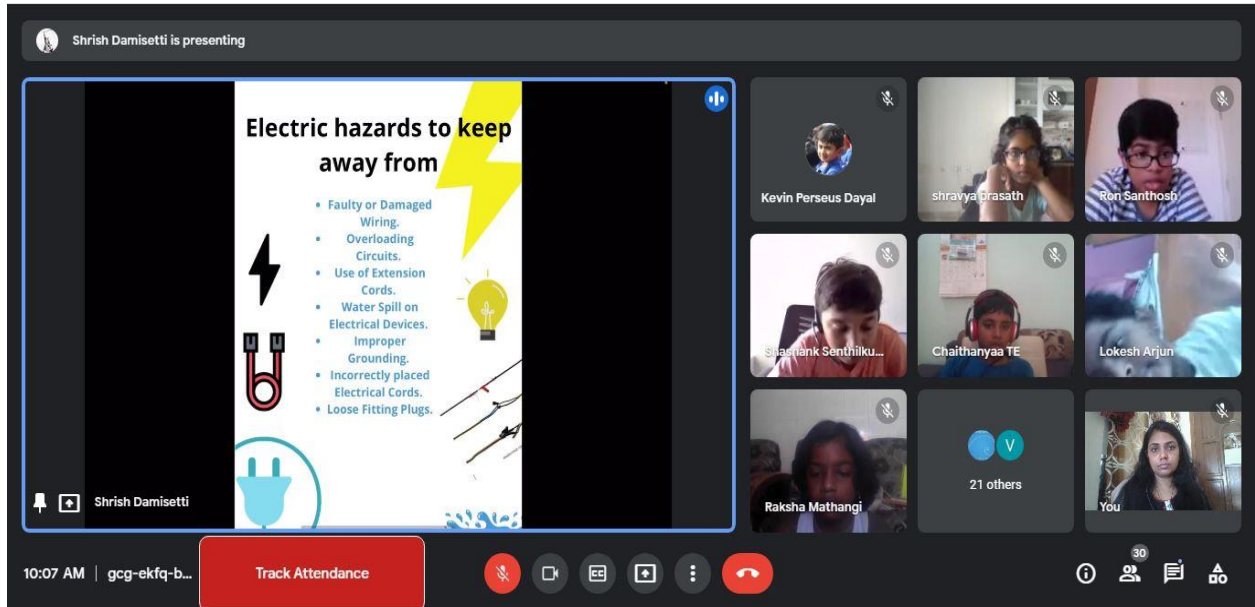
Job Alike Session – 4th Sep 2021

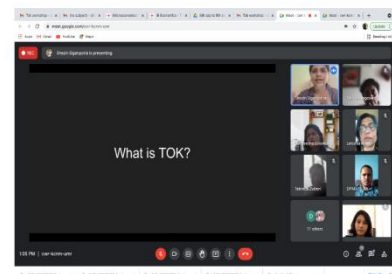
Awareness on Electrical hazards and Safety – 9th Sep 2021

Special Event Hindi Divas – 13th – 17th Sep 2021

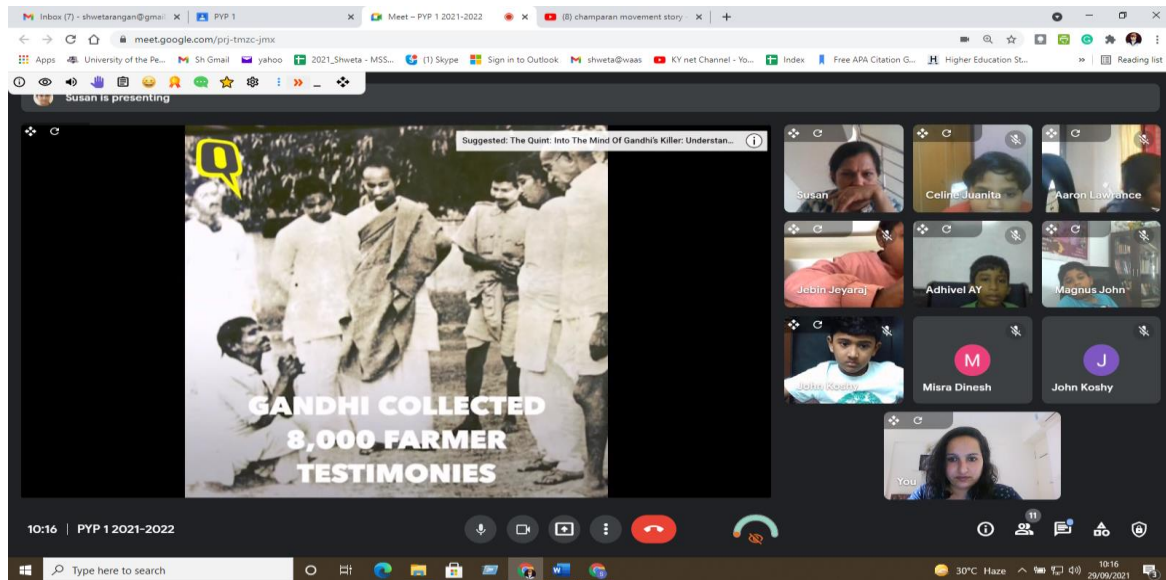
Hindi Divas was celebrated in GIS from Sep 13th to Sep 17th, 2021.

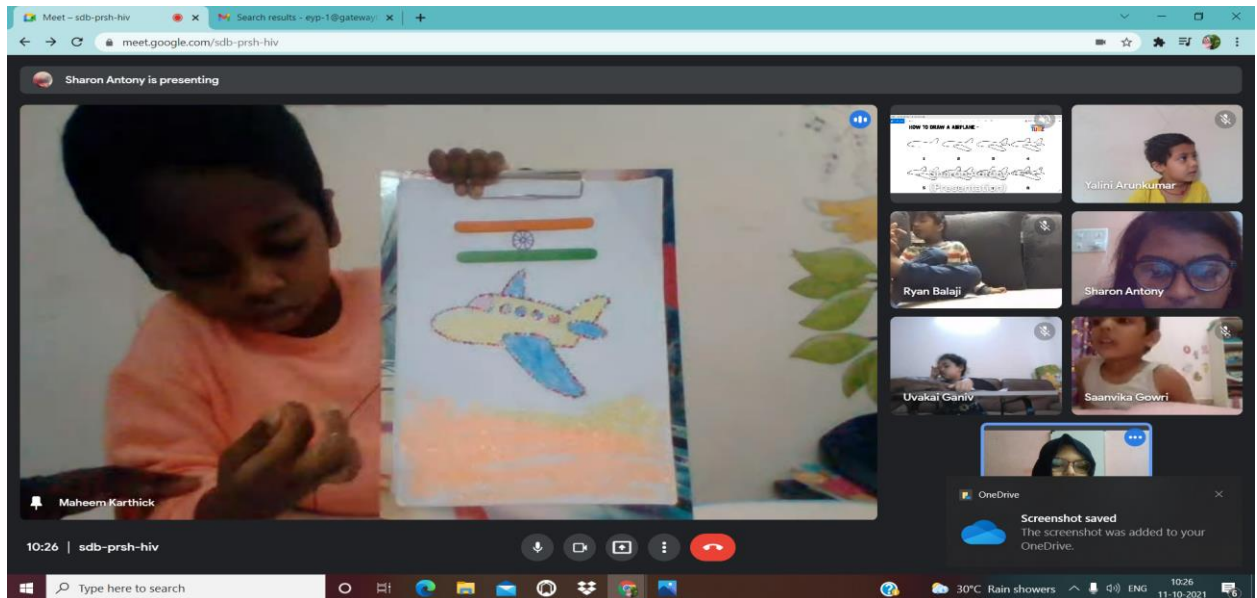
Guest lecture on Screen casting and Screenplay – 8th Oct 2021

Back to School –Students of MYP – 15th Nov 2021

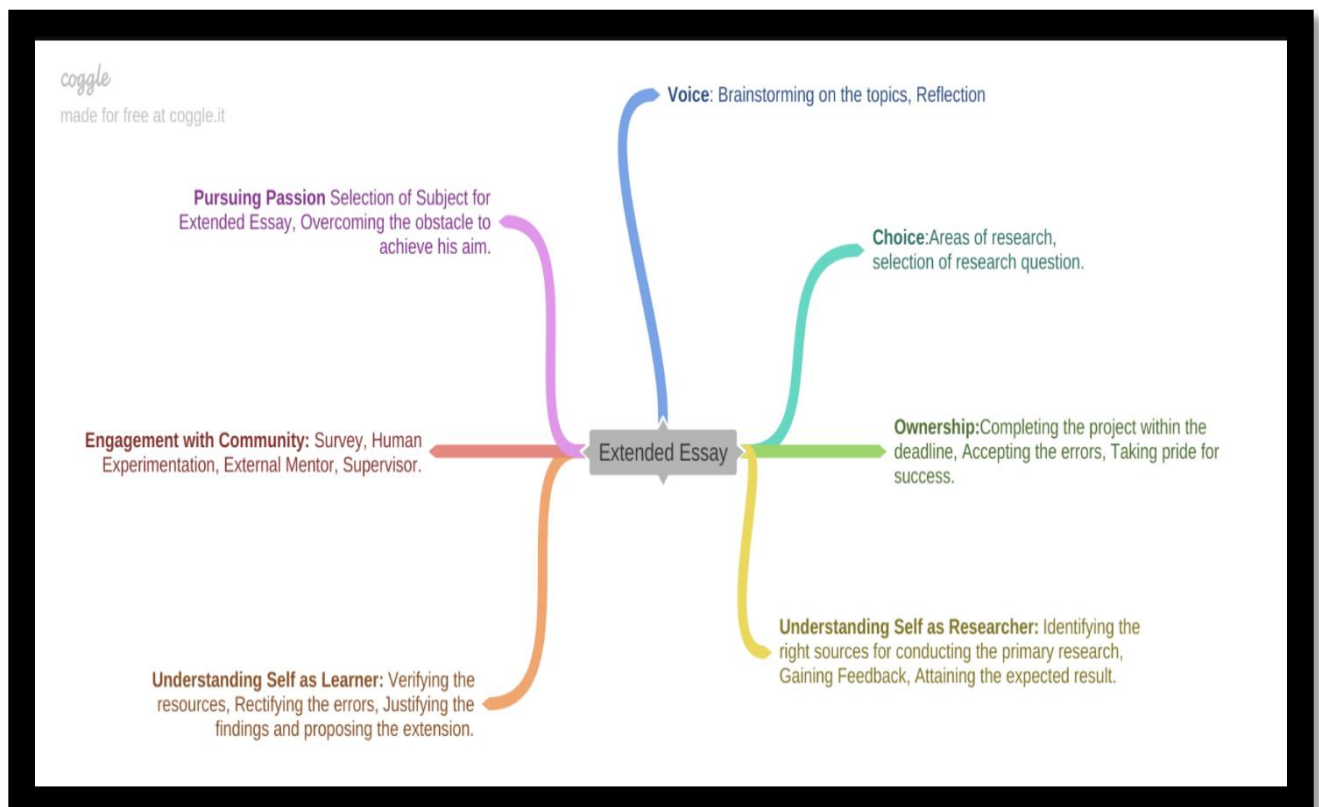

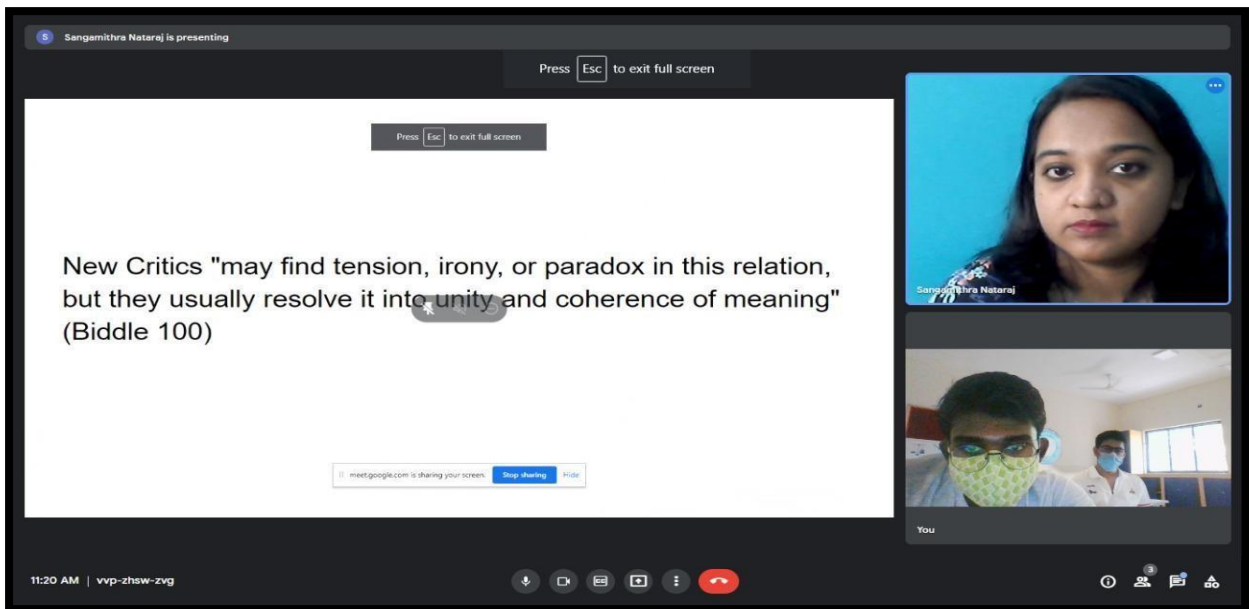
IBDP Core Workshop – 19th and 20th Nov 2021

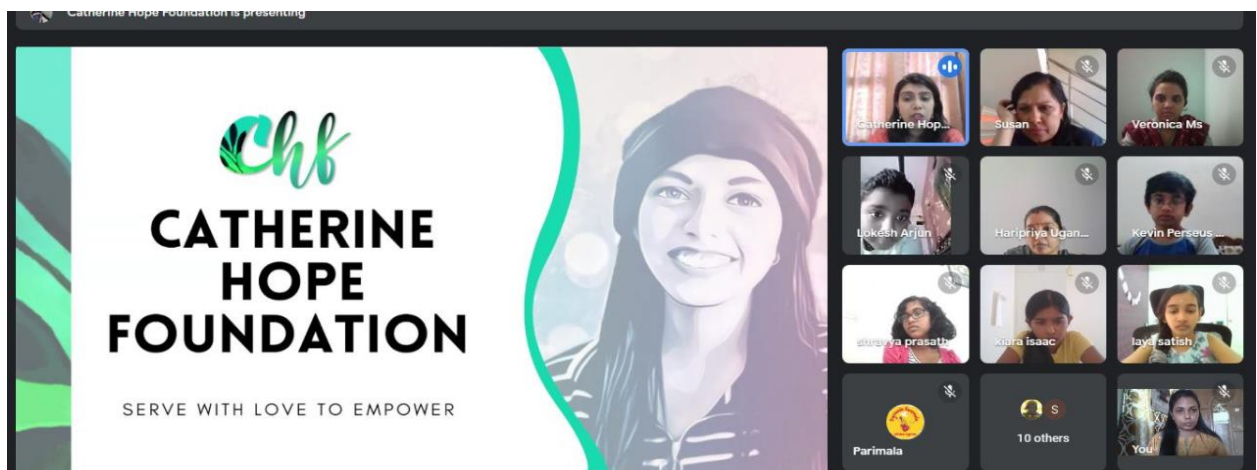
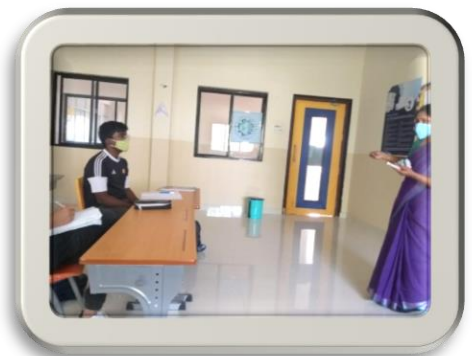
Guest Lecture – Feminism and Feminist Criticism- 25th Nov 2021

Guest speaker: Graciana Selvinson

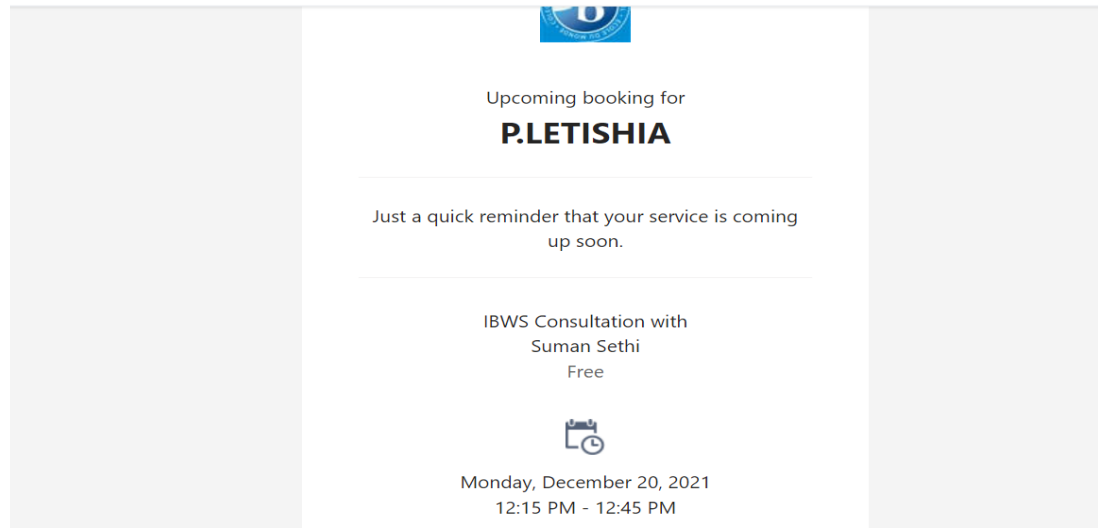

SLC – MYP – 8th Jan 2022

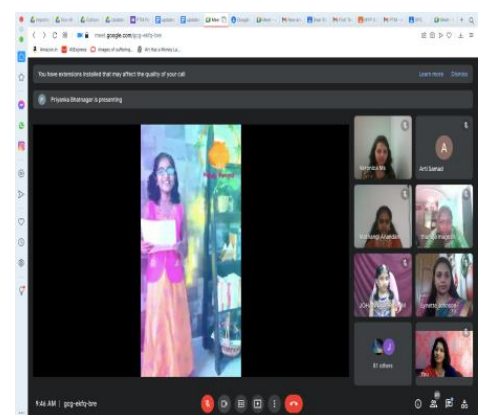

A student-led conference is a pre-planned meeting in which students demonstrate responsibility for their academic performance by providing a review of their work for parents and teachers.



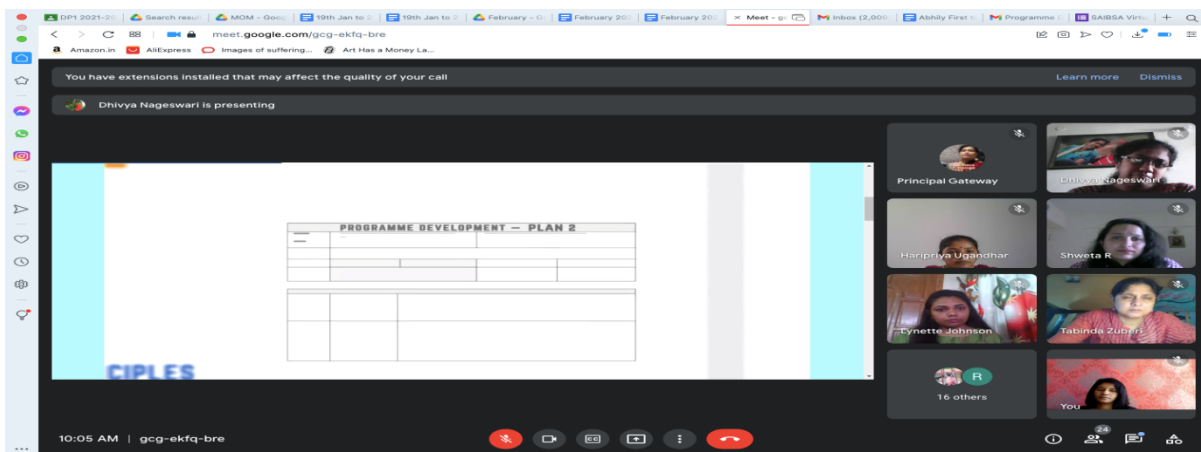
Pongal celebrations – 13th Jan 2022

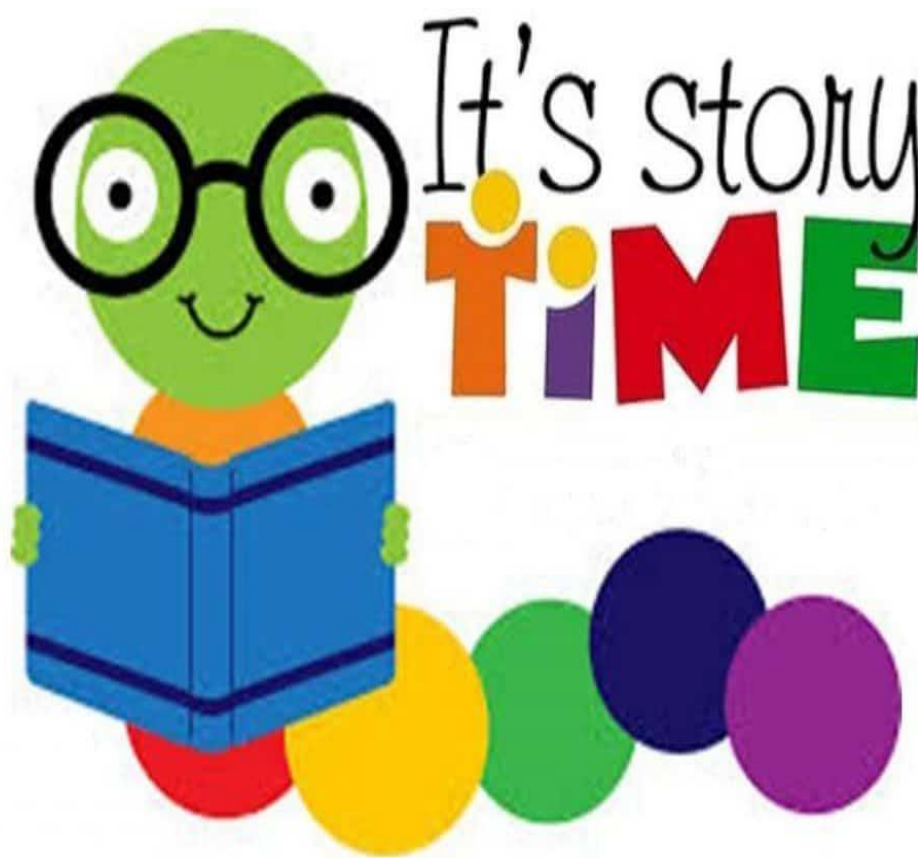


Programme Development Plan Evaluation Visit – 22nd Jan 2022

The Head of the School conducted a whole school meeting between 10am to 12noon in view of the evaluation visit.



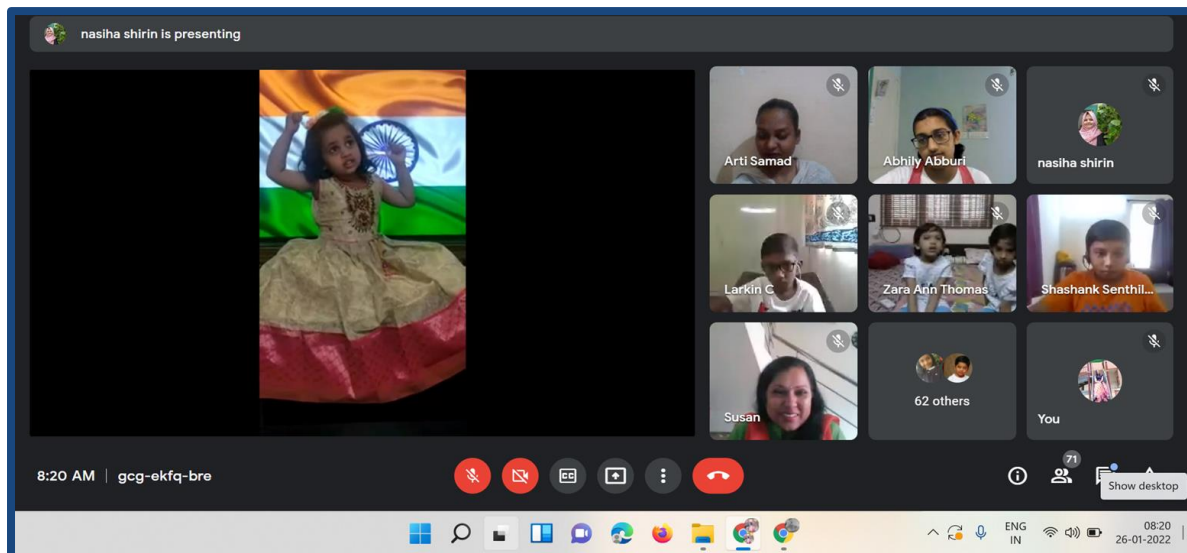
Guest Lecture – Story time with Ms.Hannah – 21st Jan 2022

Virtual Republic Day Competition – 24th Jan 2022

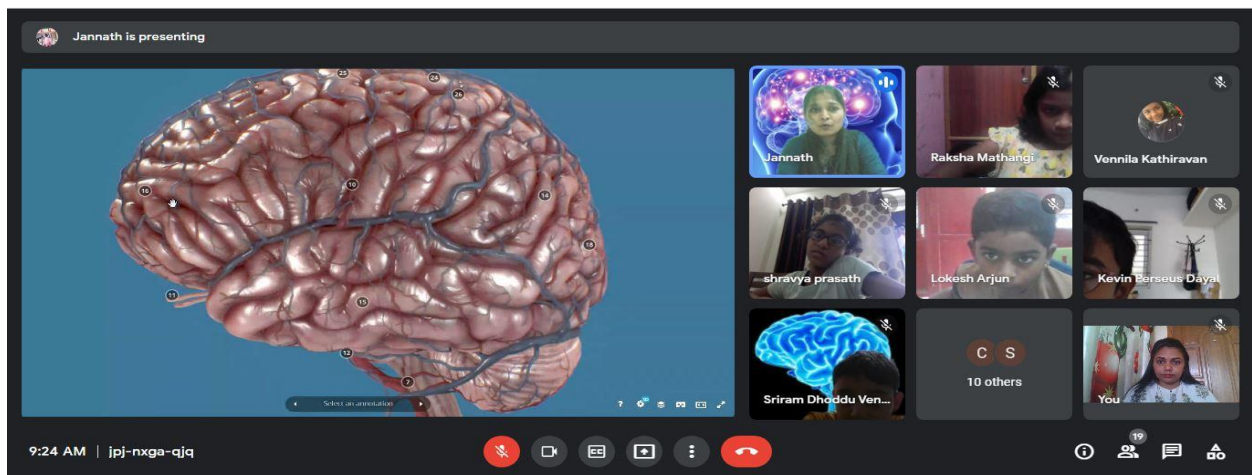

February 2022

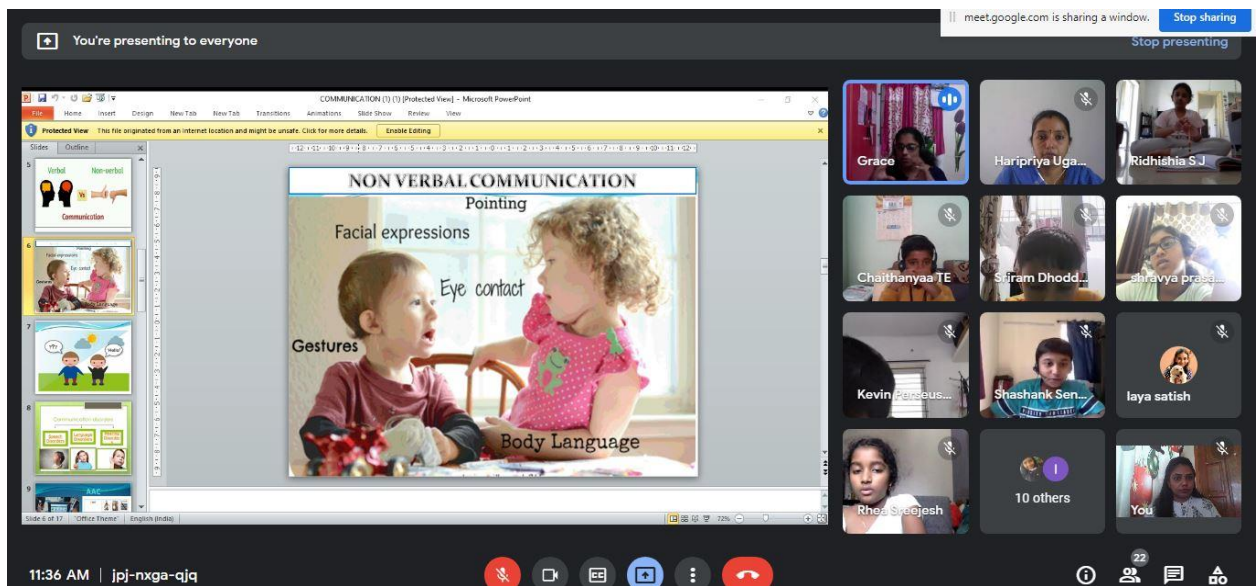
Guest Lecture - Analytical Brain Vs Creative Brain – 2nd Feb 2022

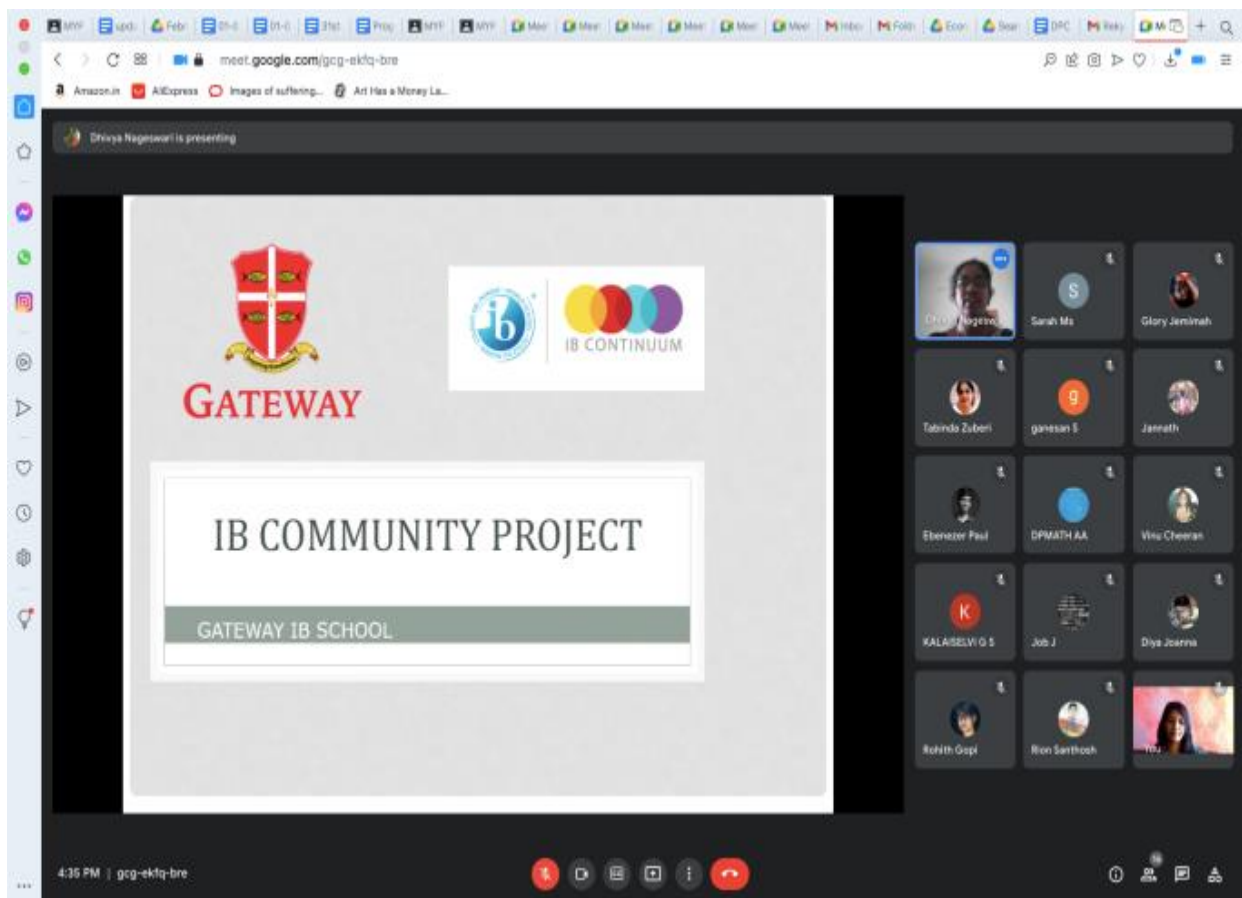
Guest Lecture – Non Verbal Communication Methods – 2nd Feb 2022

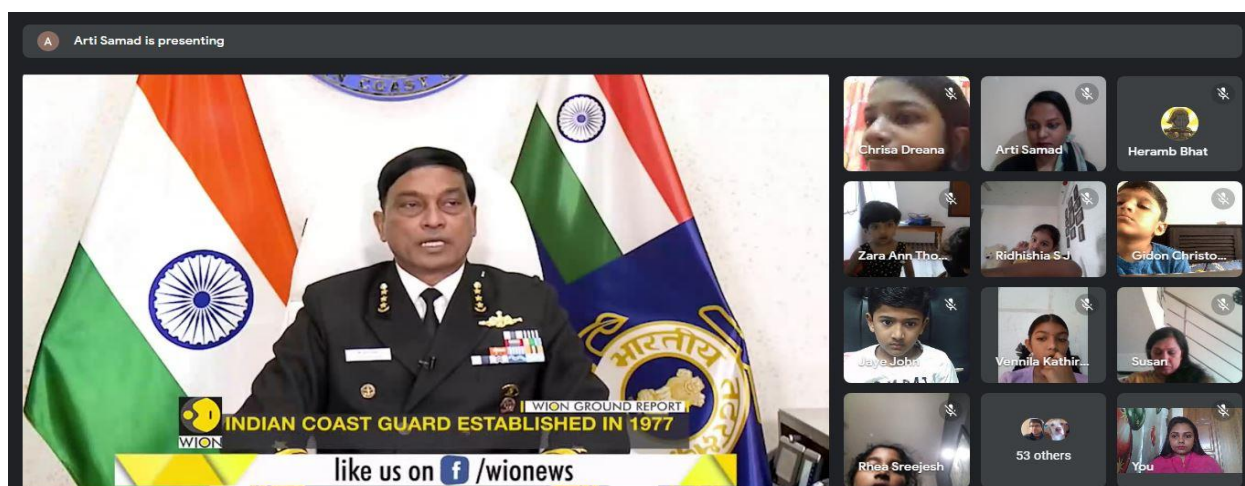
Community Project Orientation – 3rd Feb 2022

Guest Lecture by Mr. Allan – Selected Councilor for Conservative Party, London, United Kingdom

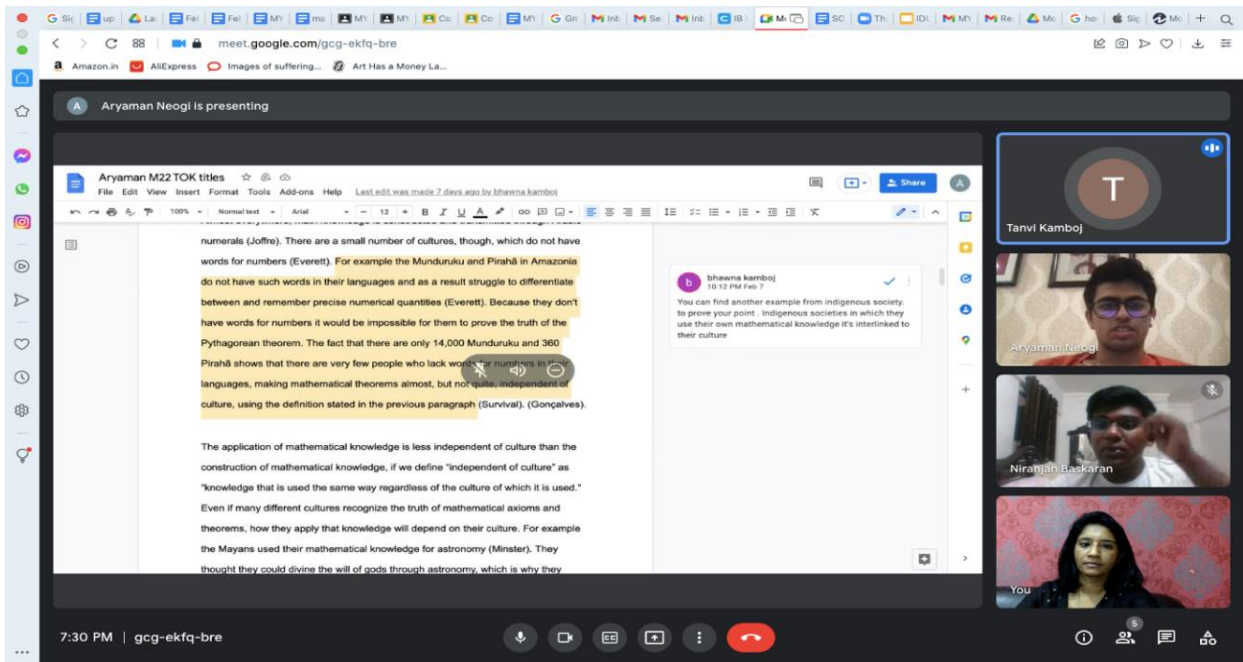

To enable our students to get clarity on the essay writing and to score the highest mark, a virtual meeting was arranged on 14th Feb 2022. Ms Tanvi Kamboj, TOK Teacher, Pathways World School, Gurugram,

was the resource person who shared her expertise to unpack all the nuances to ace the TOK essay.

- Alternatively, the school might allocate one room per language, and stagger the starting times according to level.

World Poetry Day March 21, 2022

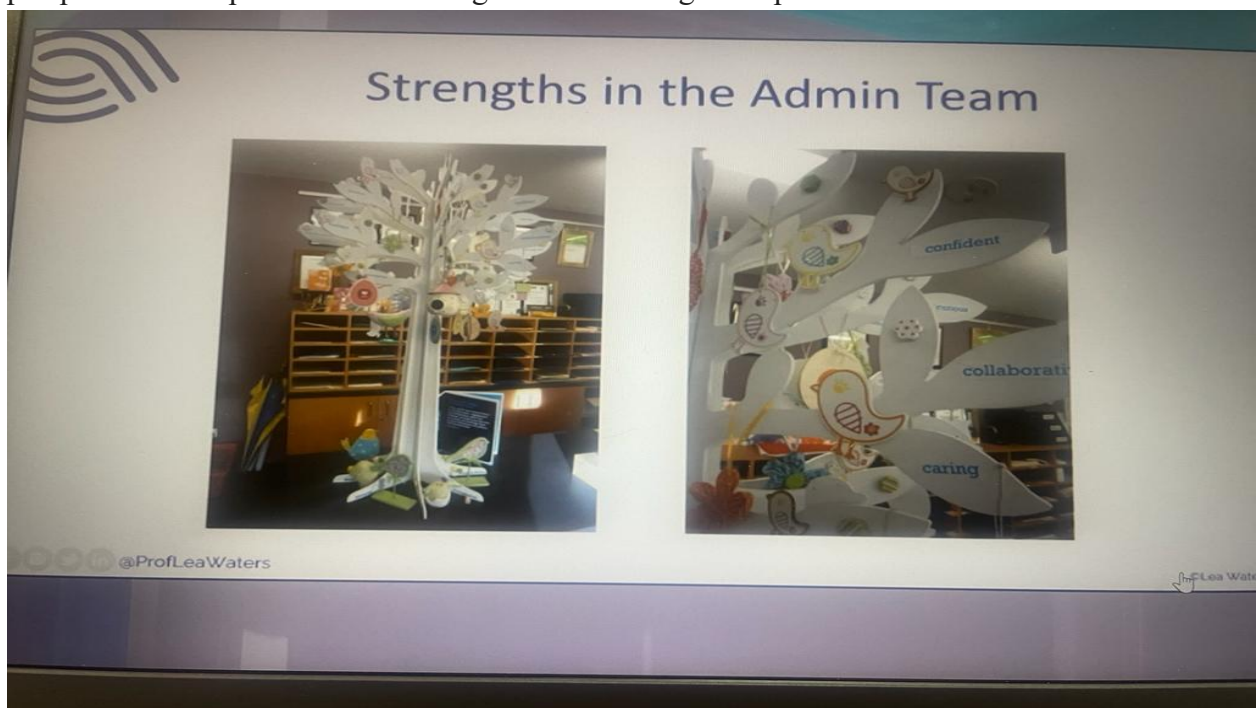
“The poetry of the Earth is never dead.” – John Keats

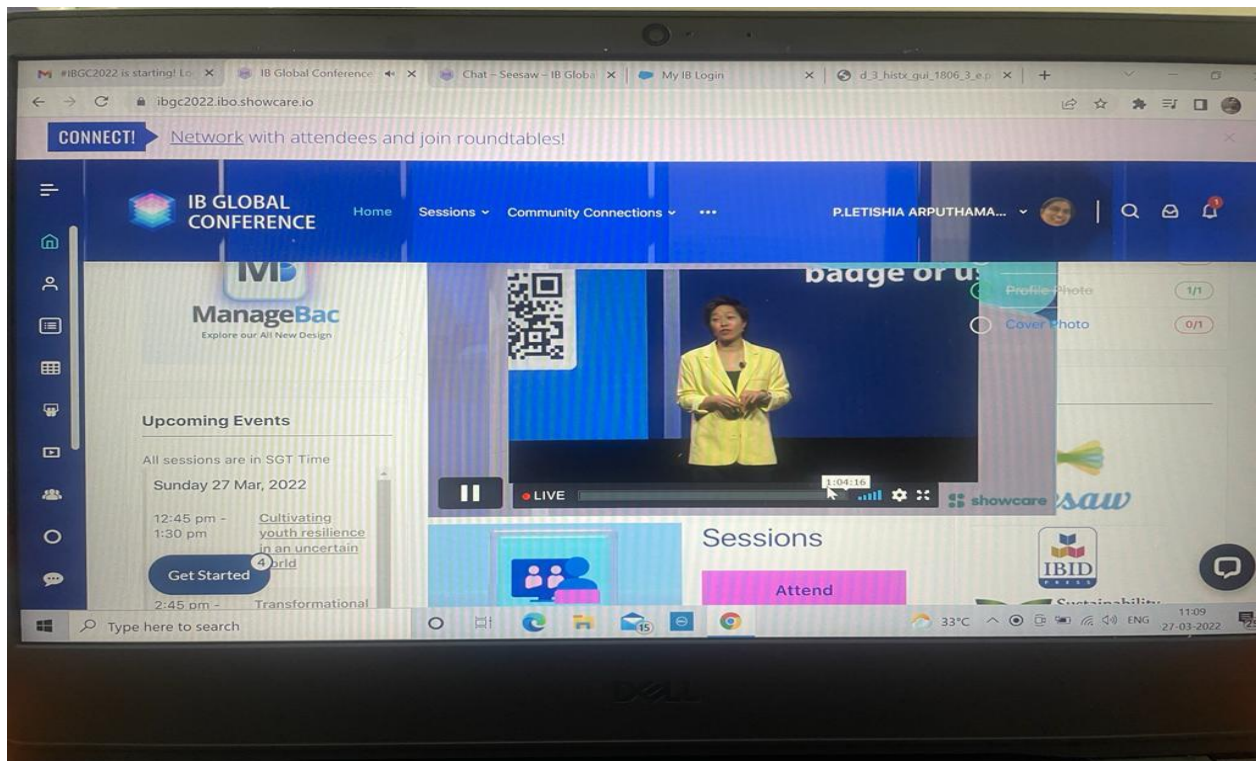
writing.

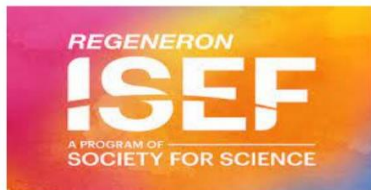
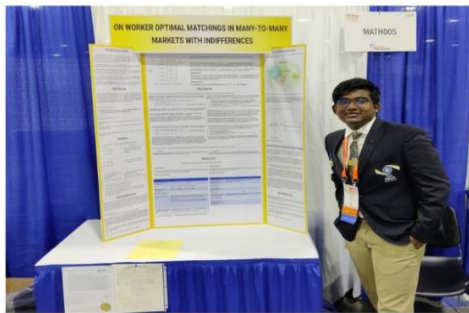

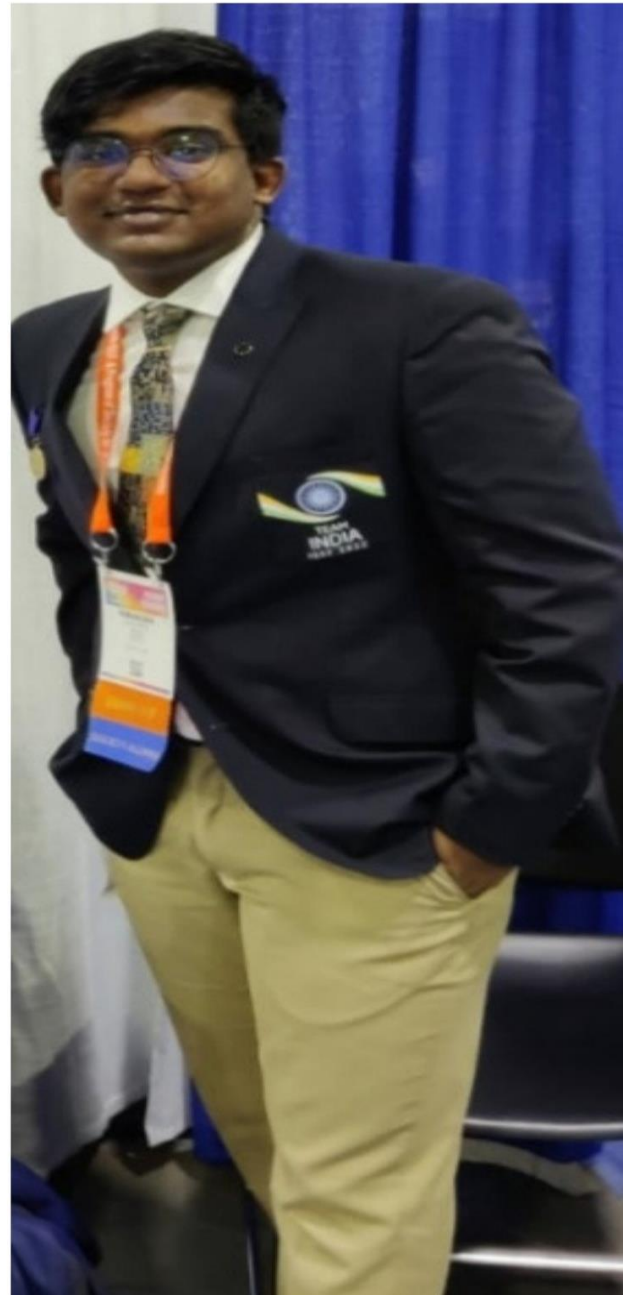

Grand Virtual Graduation -7th May 2022

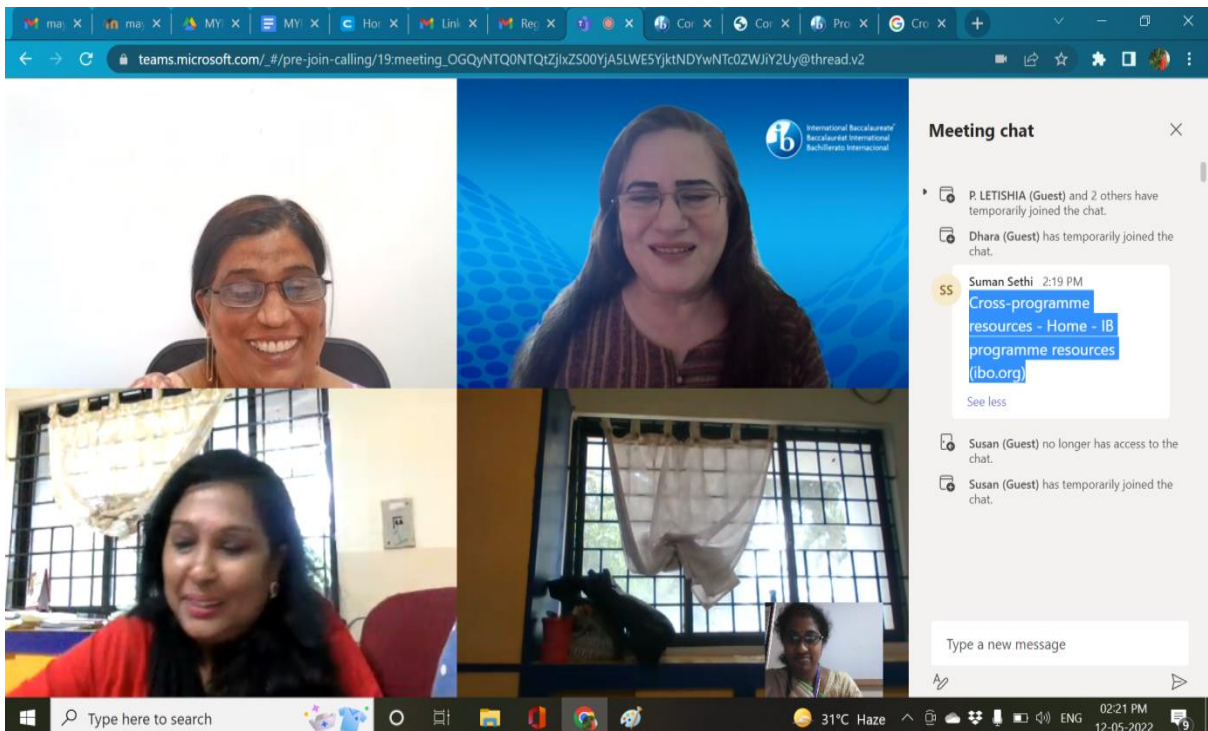
